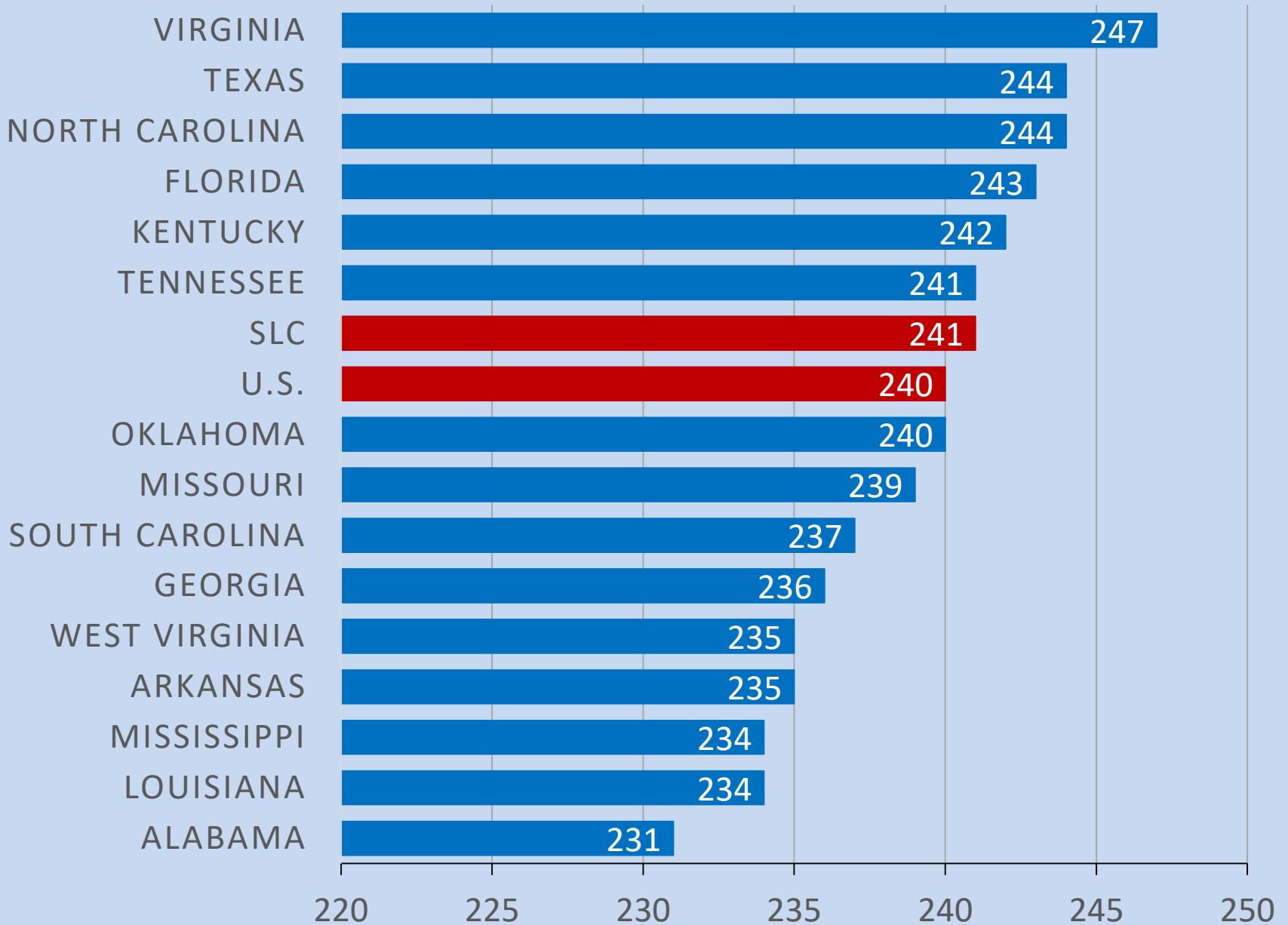

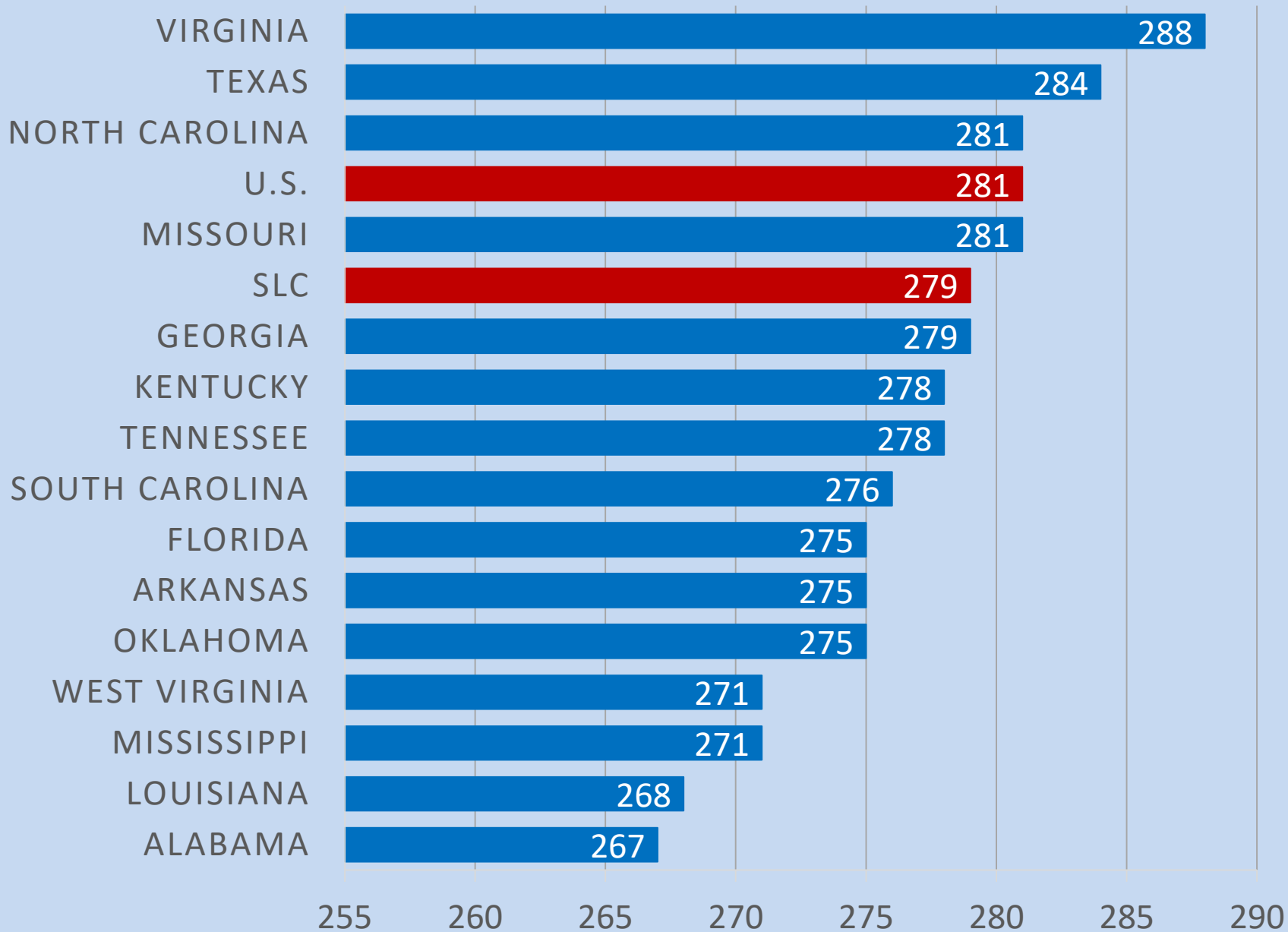

2015 4th Grade Math NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



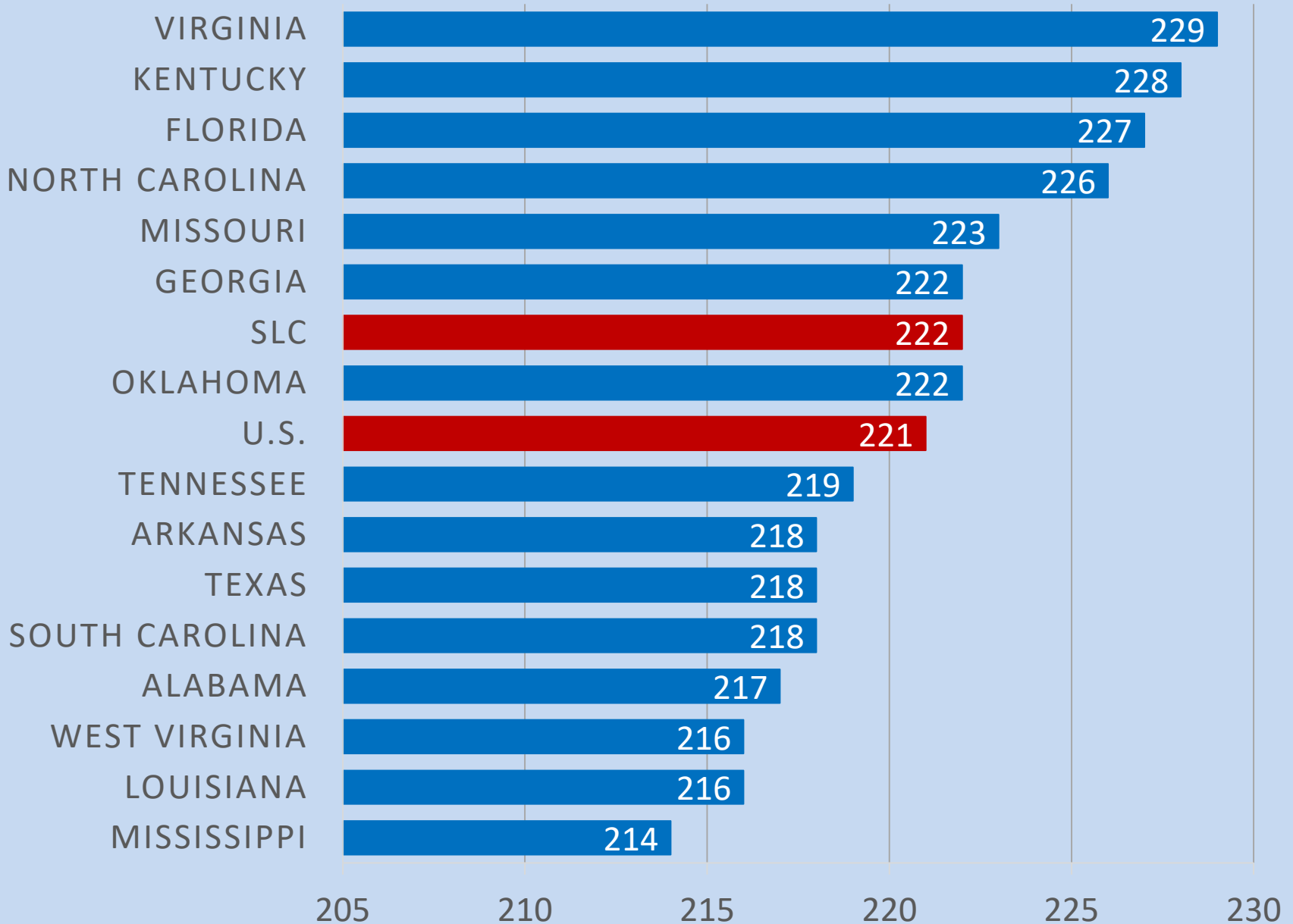

2015 8th Grade Math NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



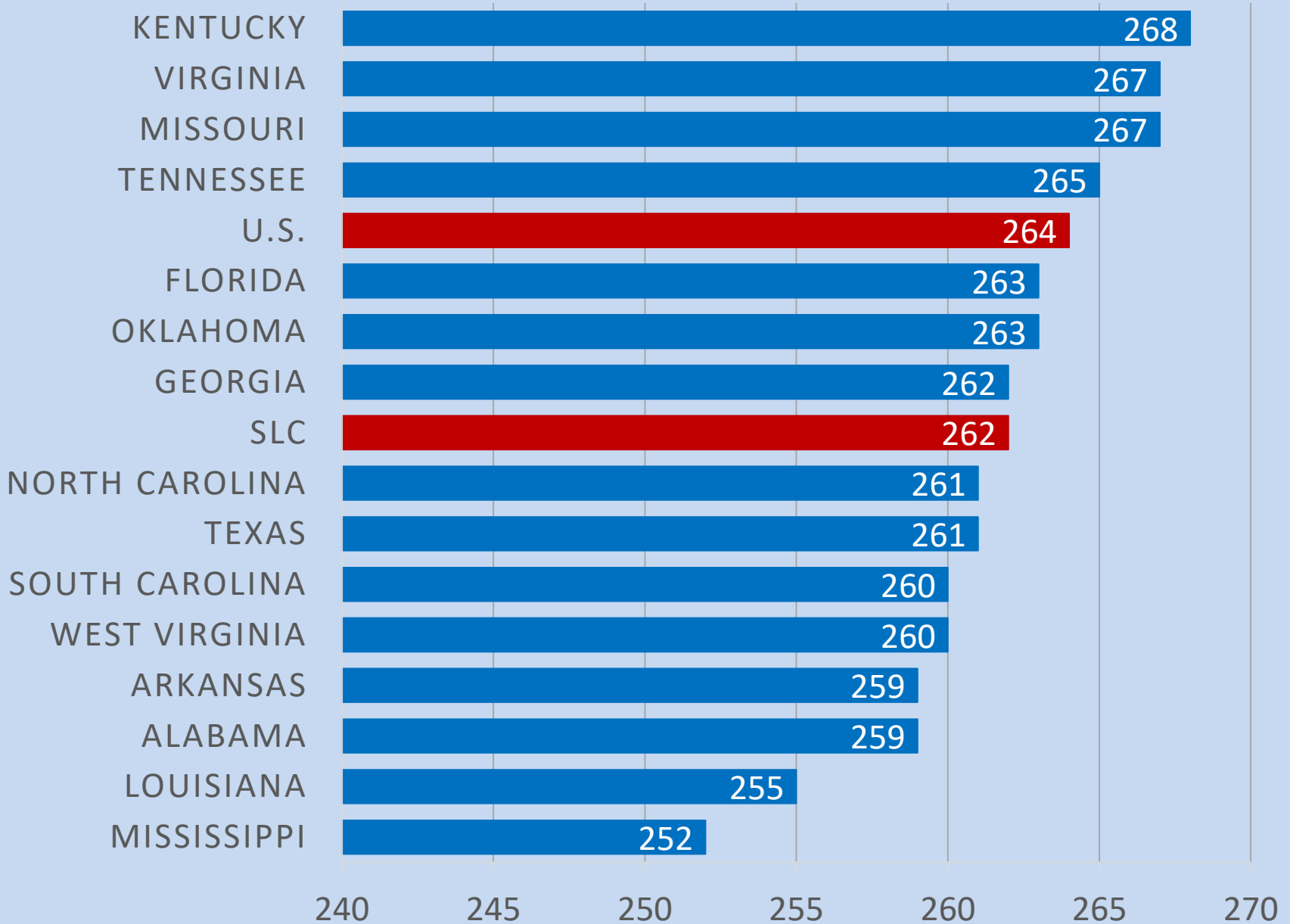

2015 4th Grade Reading NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



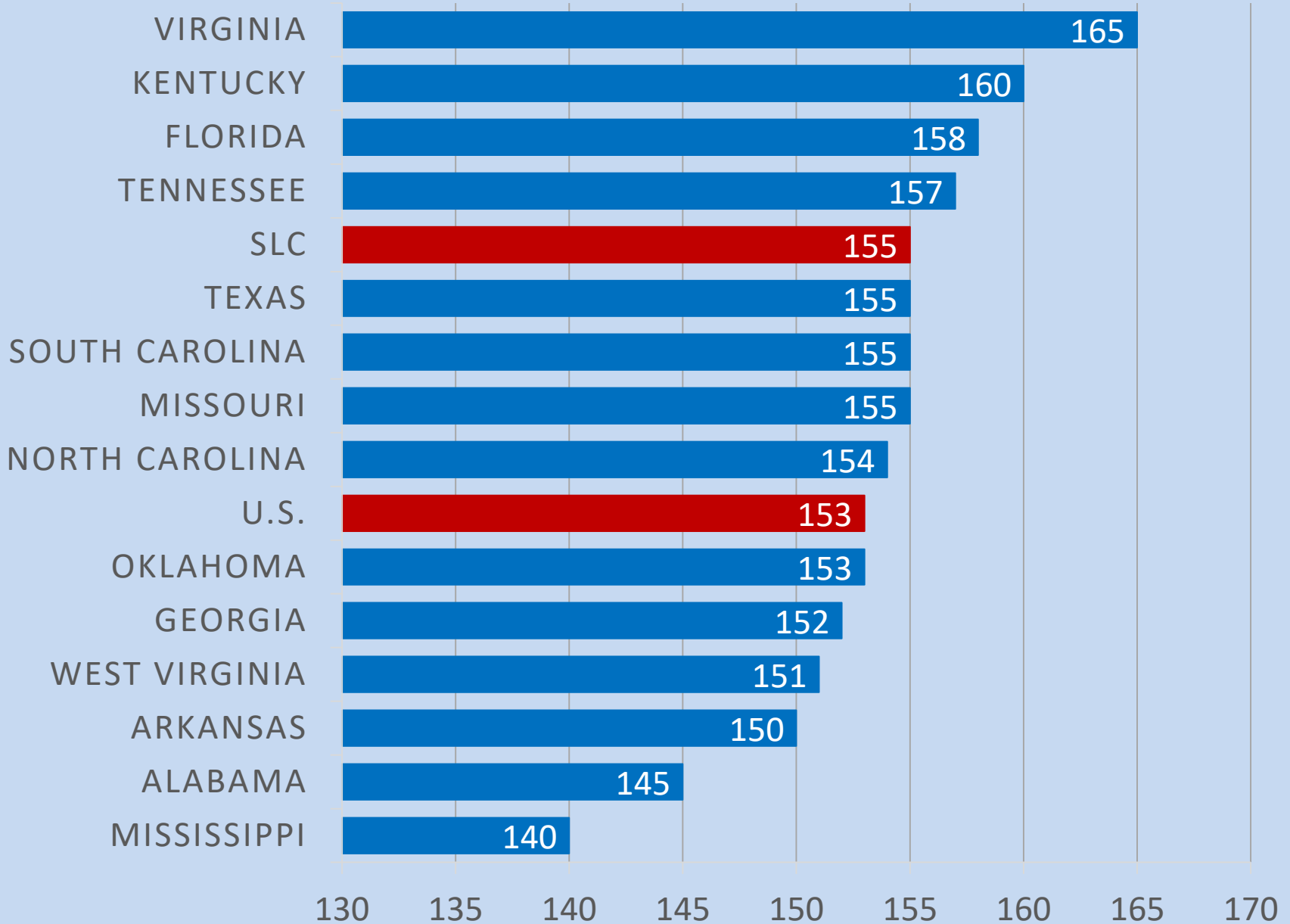

2015 8th Grade Reading NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



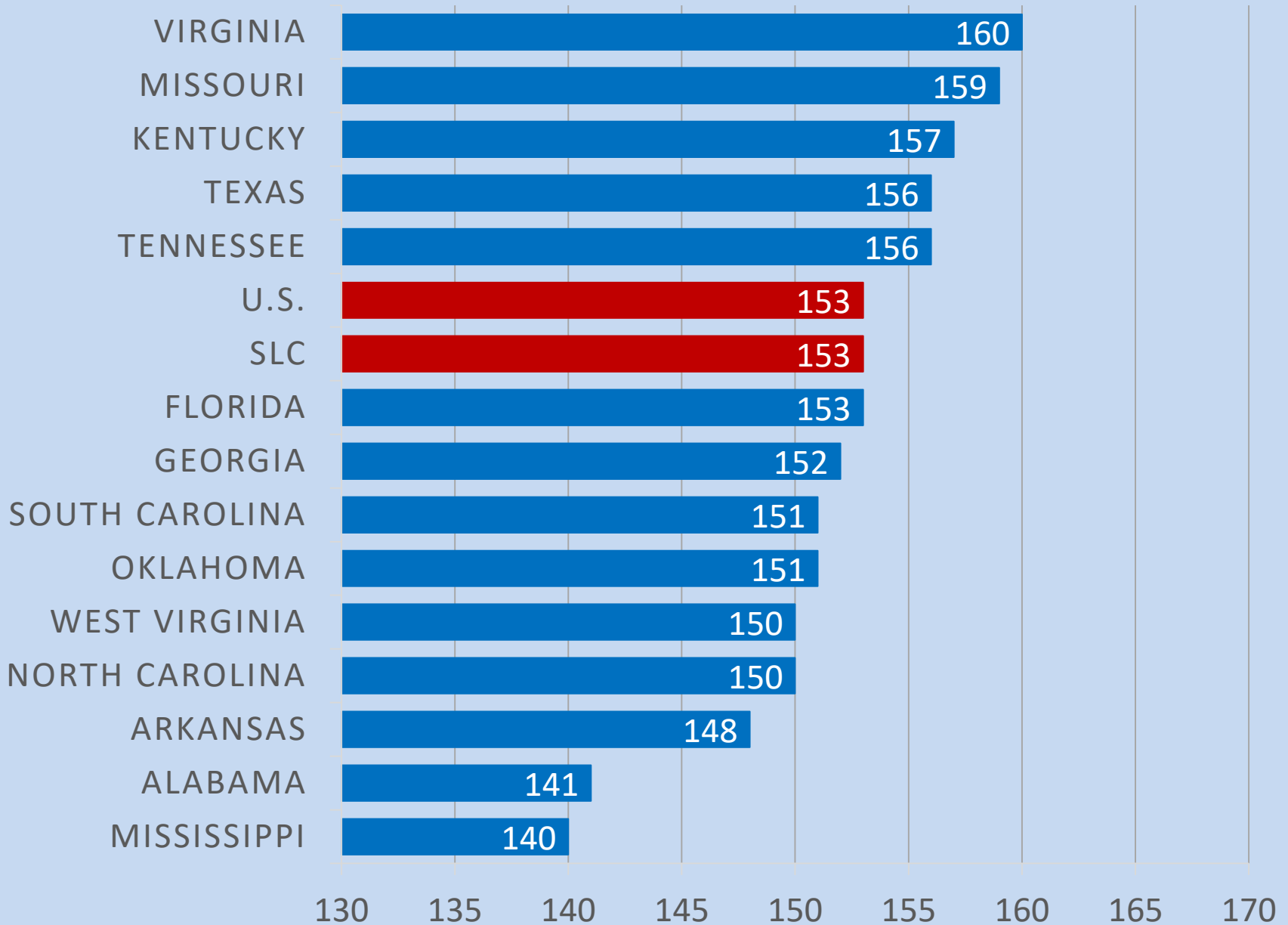

2015 4th Grade Science NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



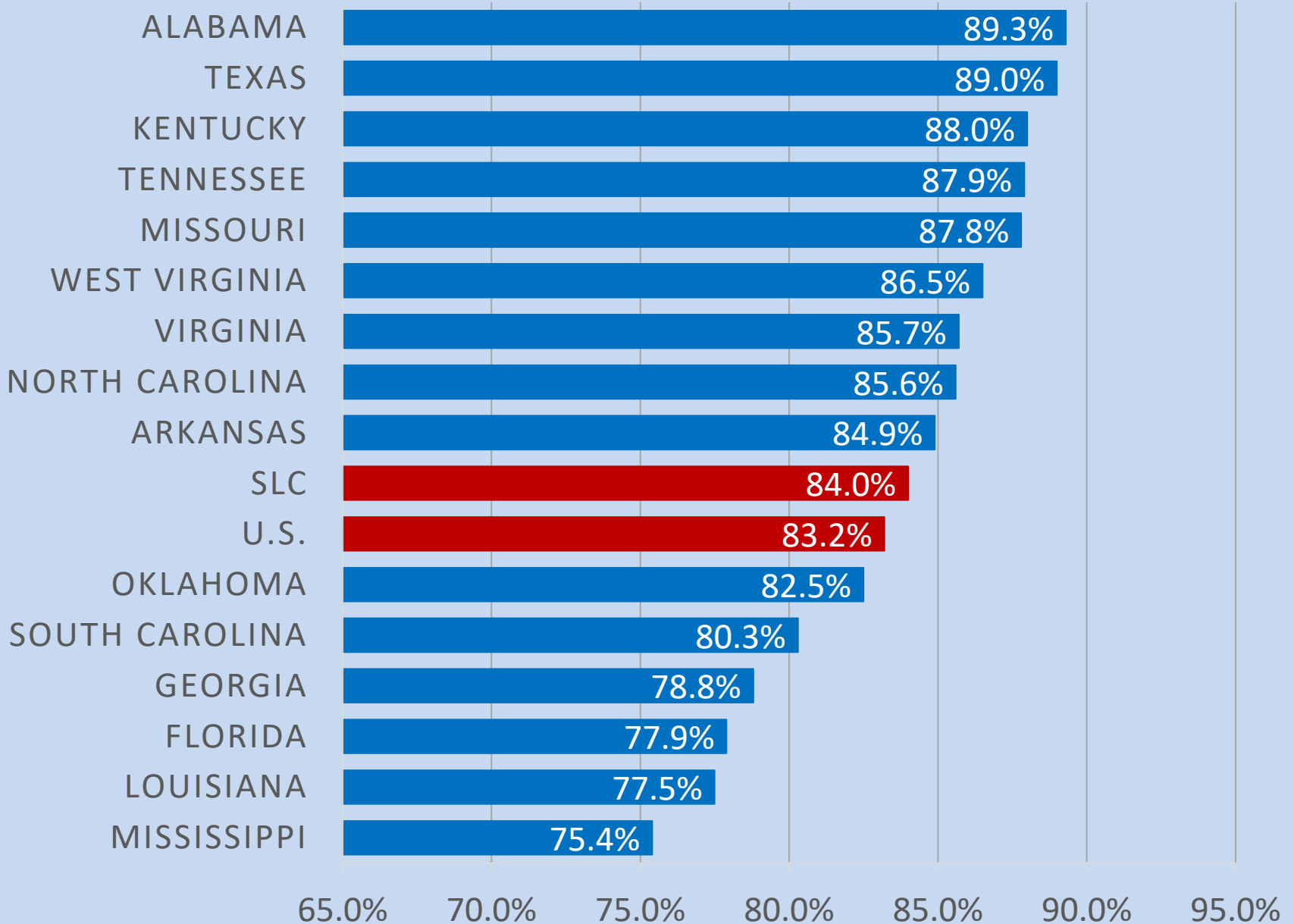

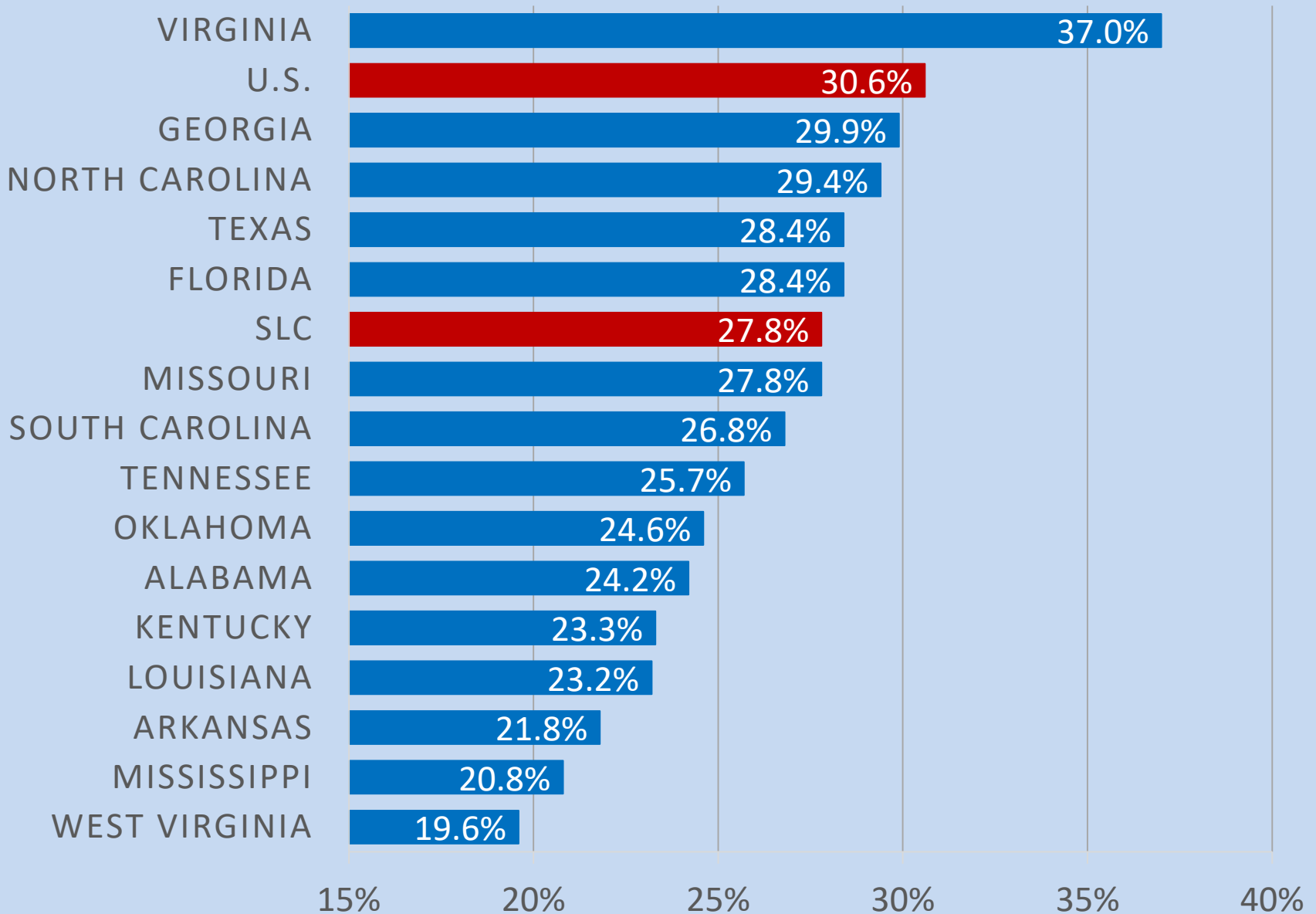
2014-2015 Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate

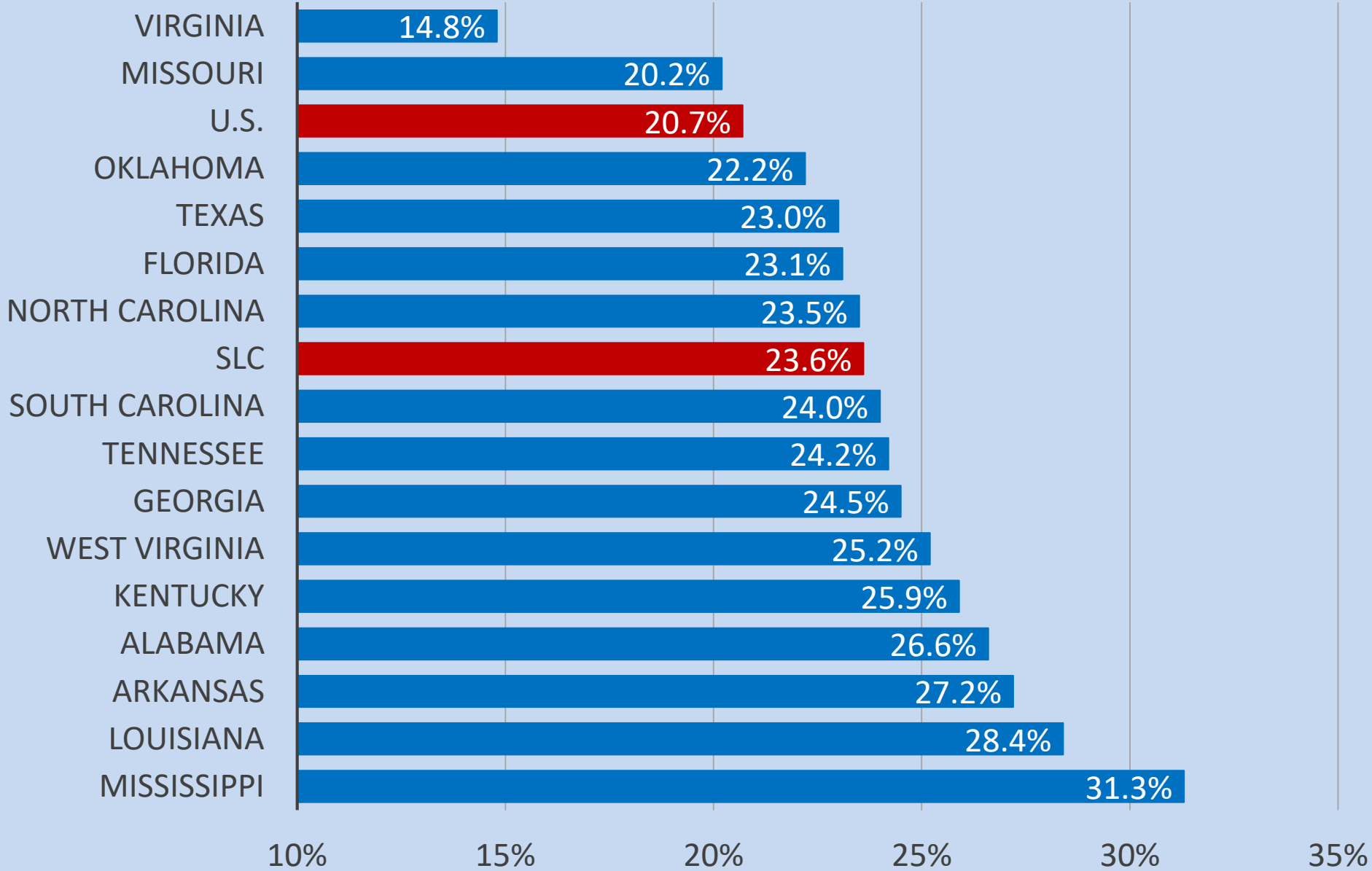
Percentage of Population 25 or older with a Bachelor's Degree (2015)



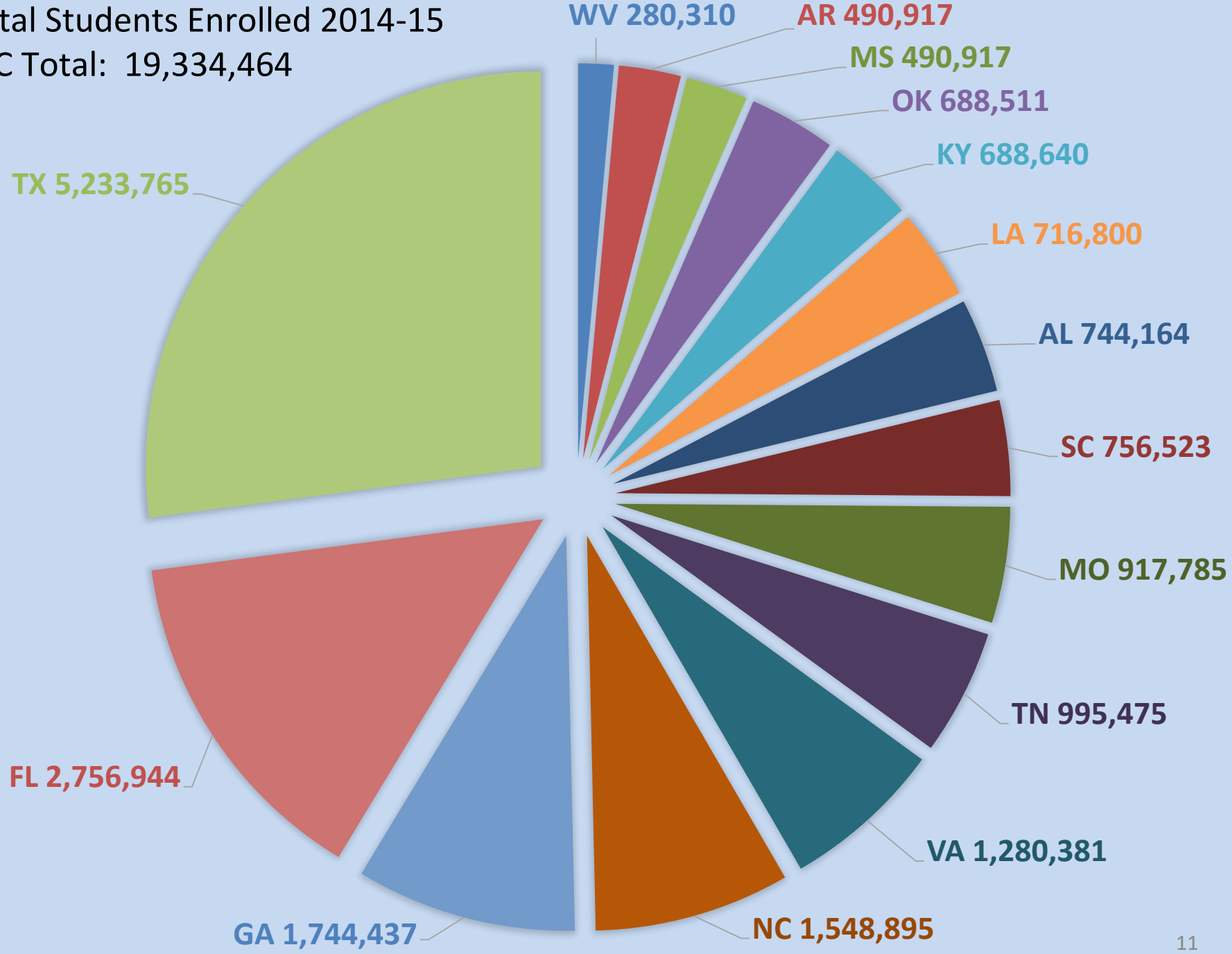

Percent of Children Under 18 Years Below Poverty Level (2015)

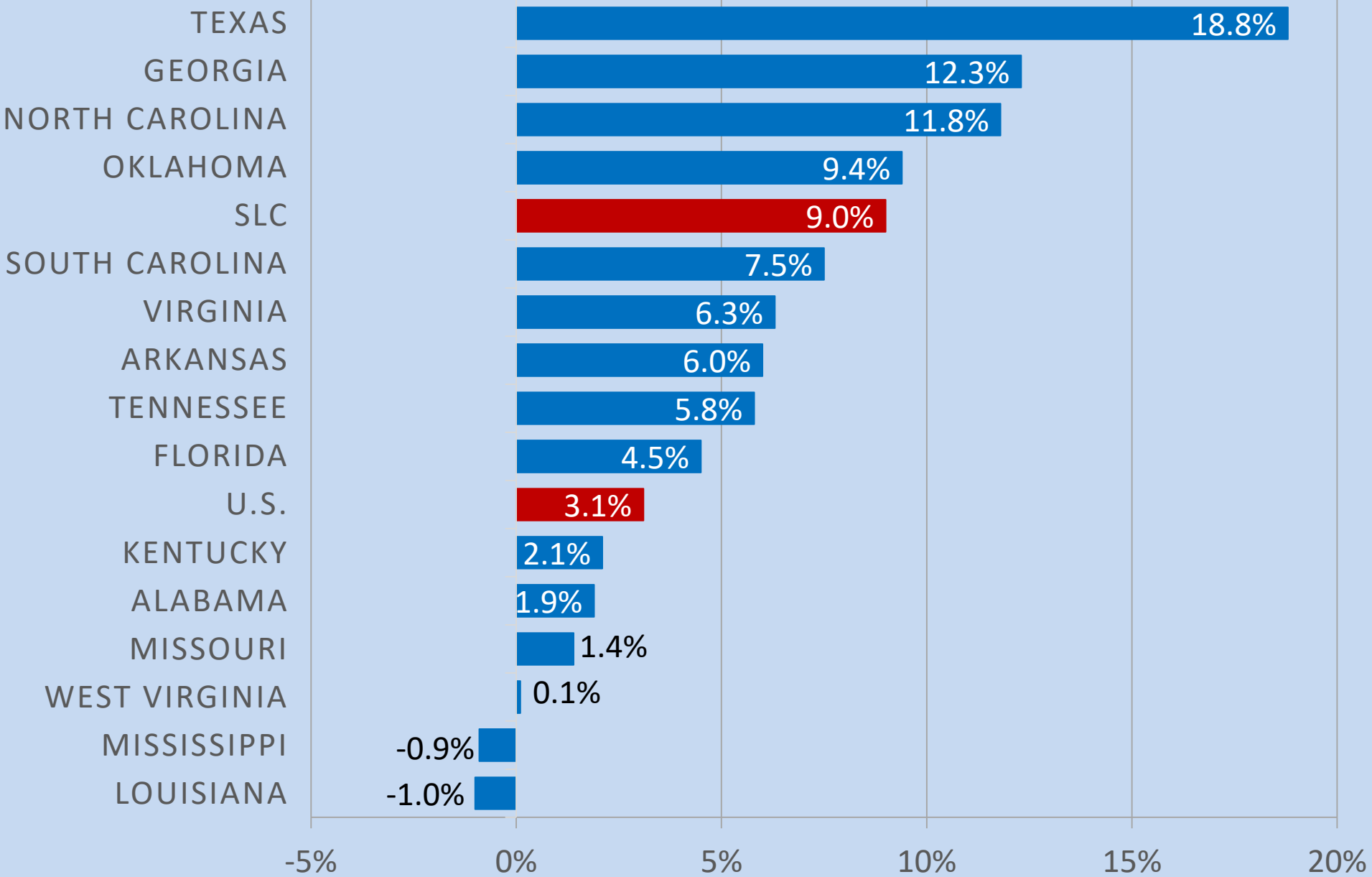

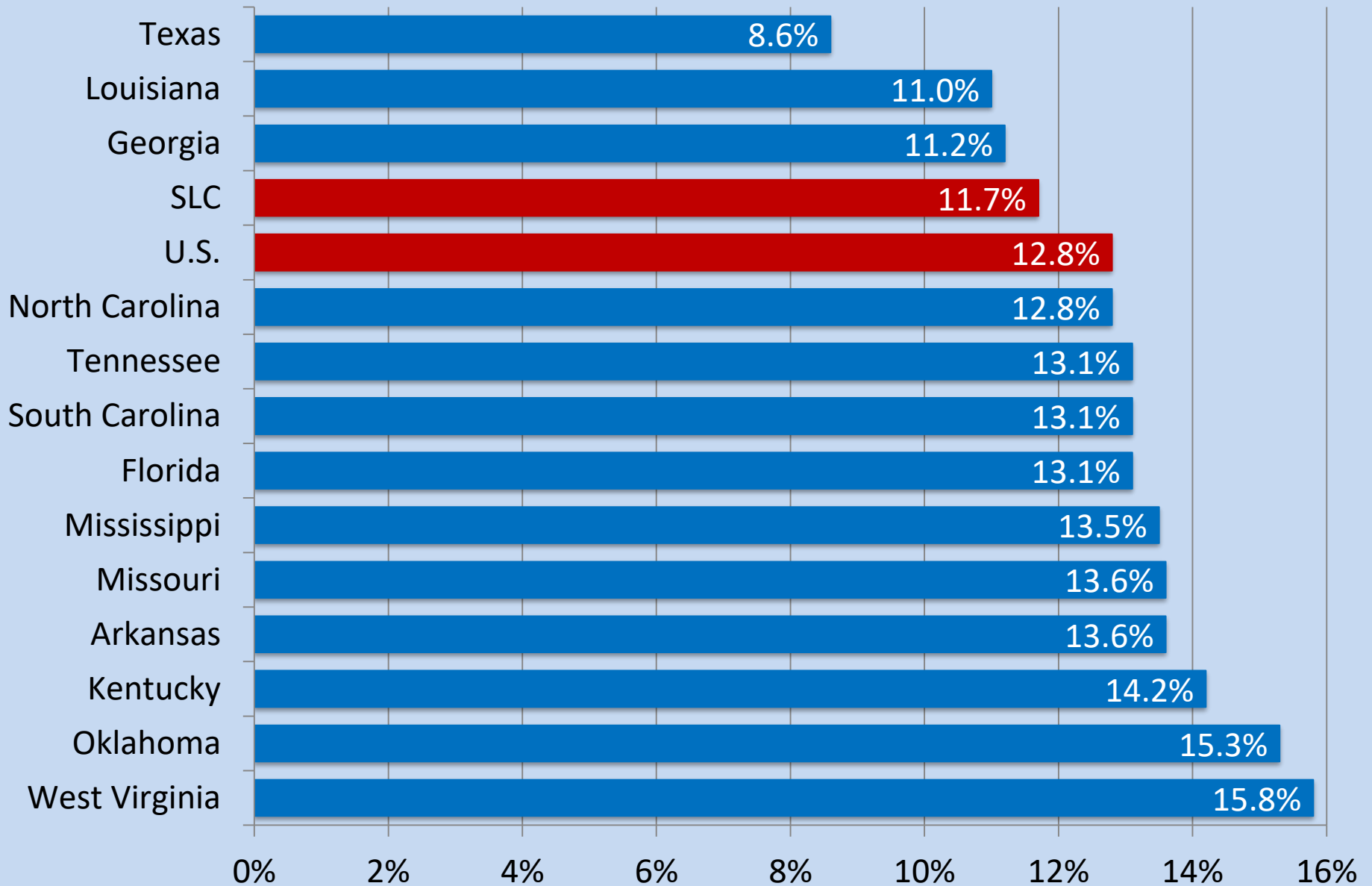

Student Enrollment 10-Year Increase (between 2004-05 and 2014-15)



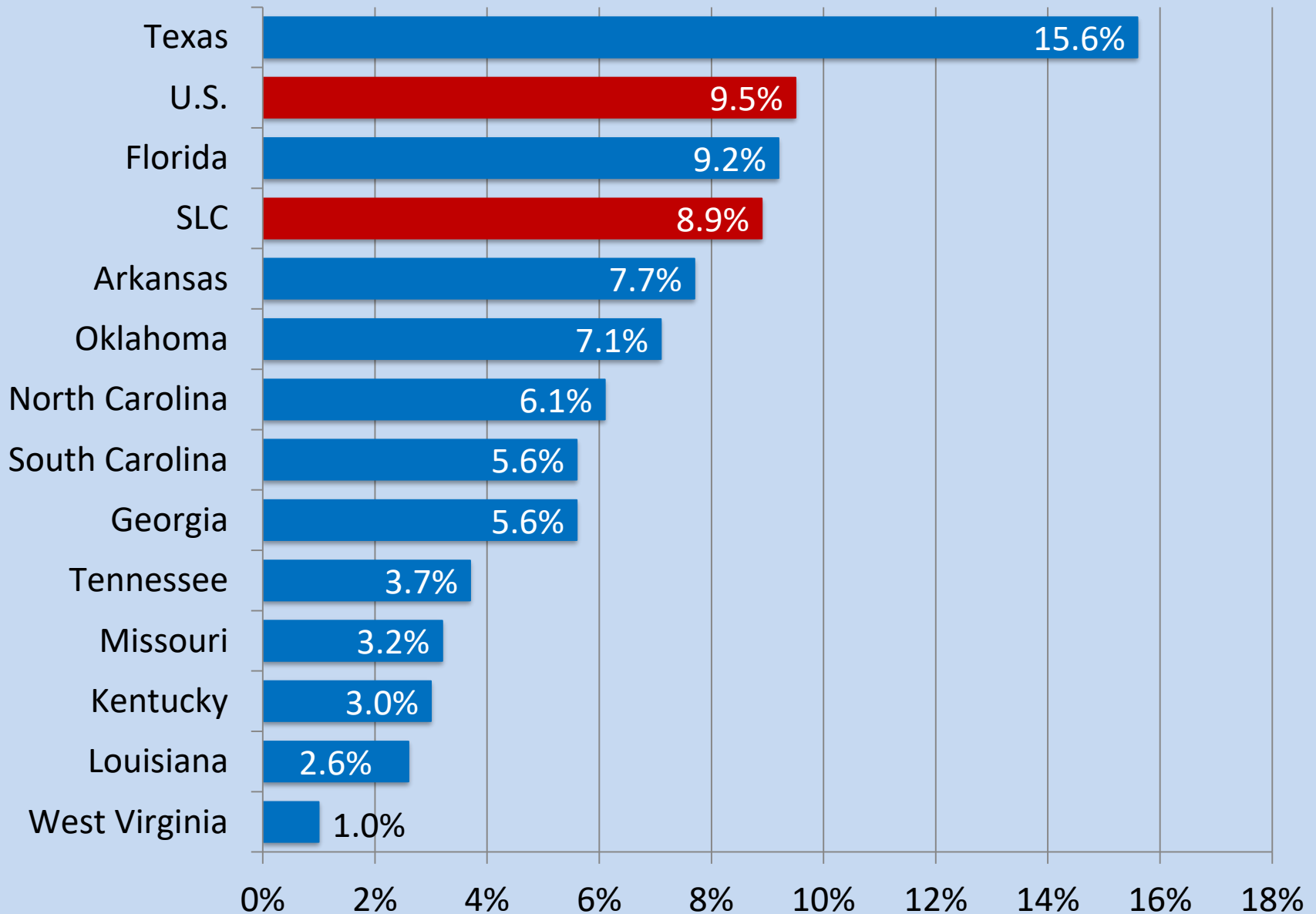

Percentage of Students with IEPs (2014-15)



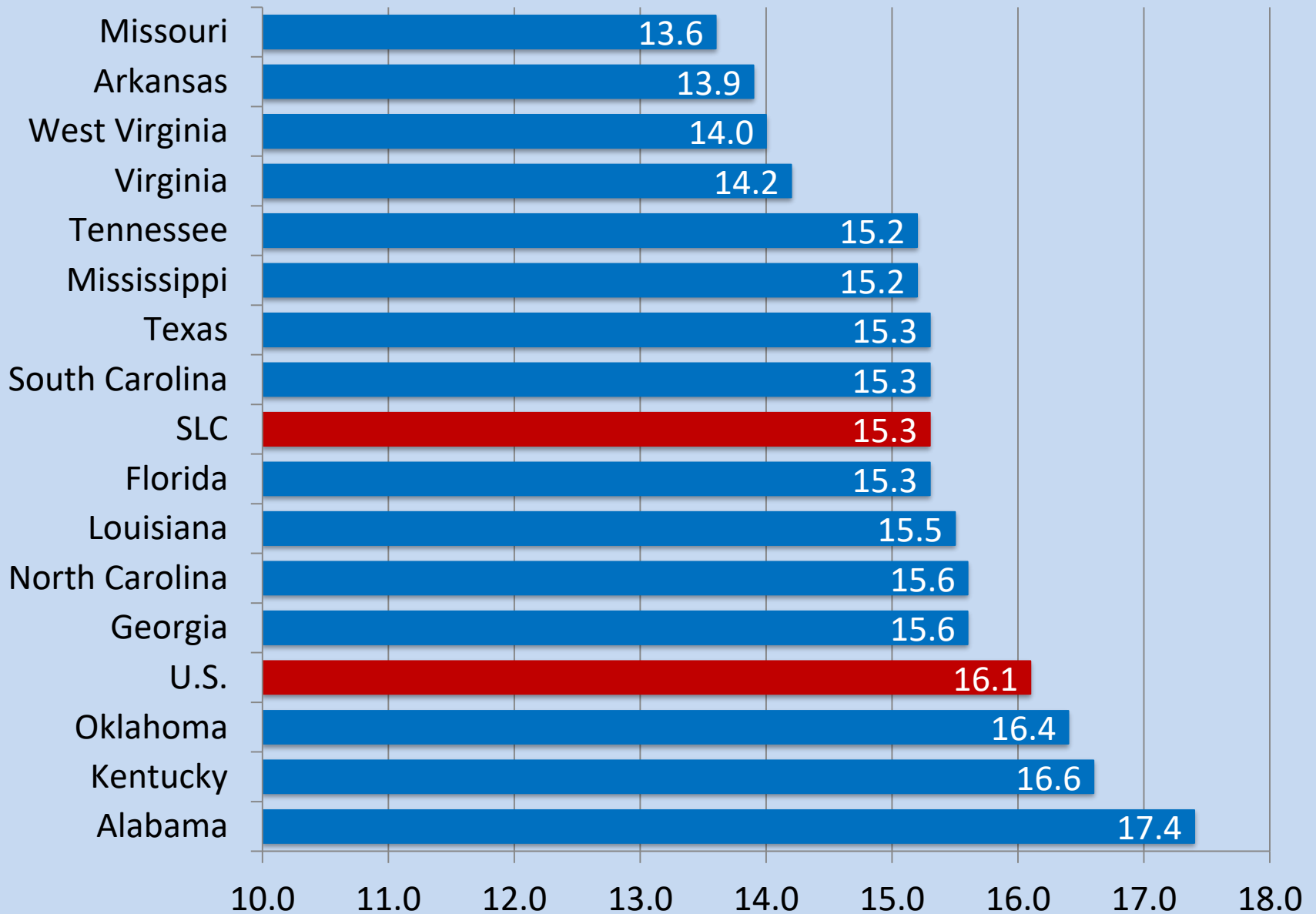

Percentage of Students in LEP Programs (2014-15)

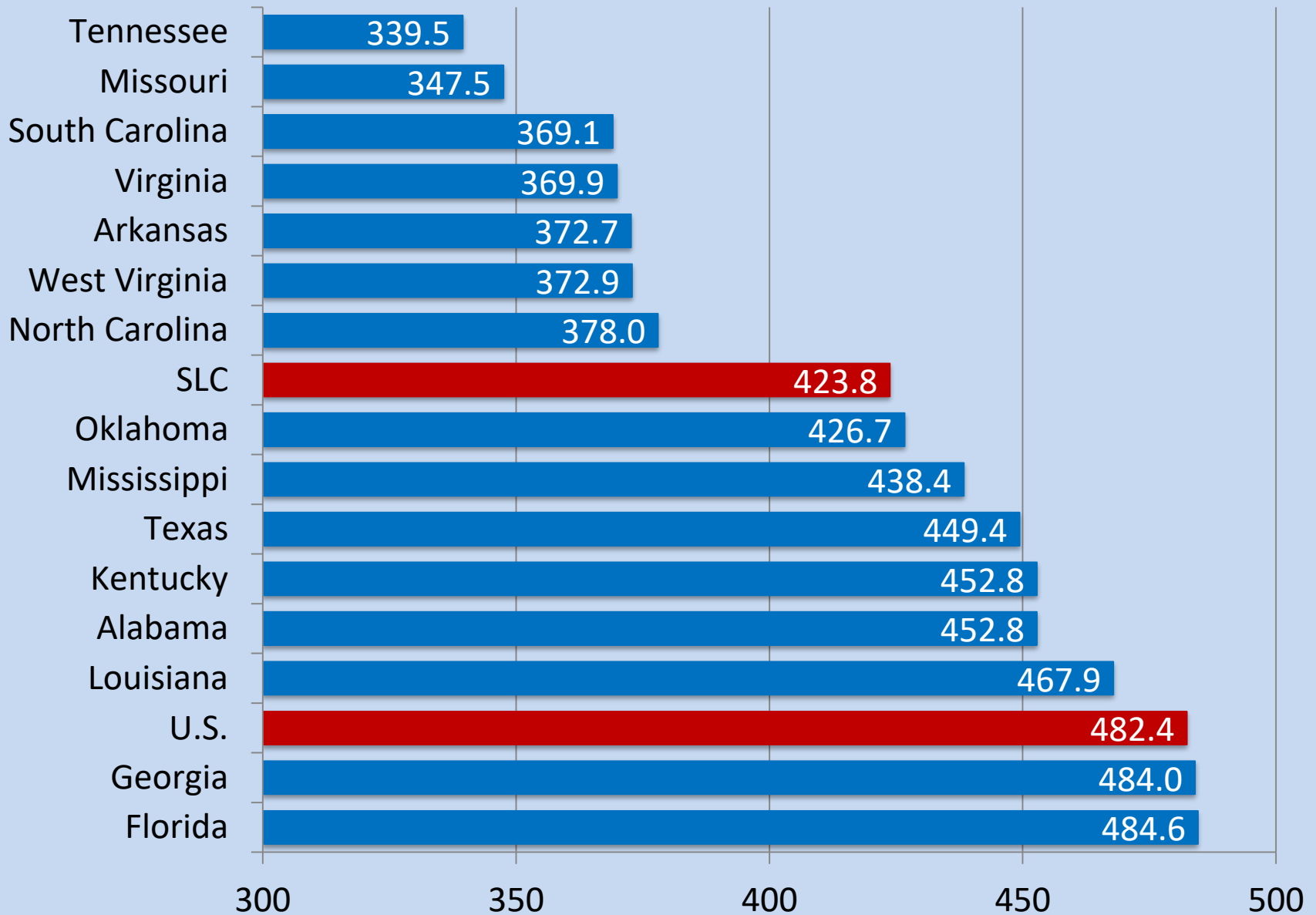

Pupil-Teacher Ratio (2014-15)

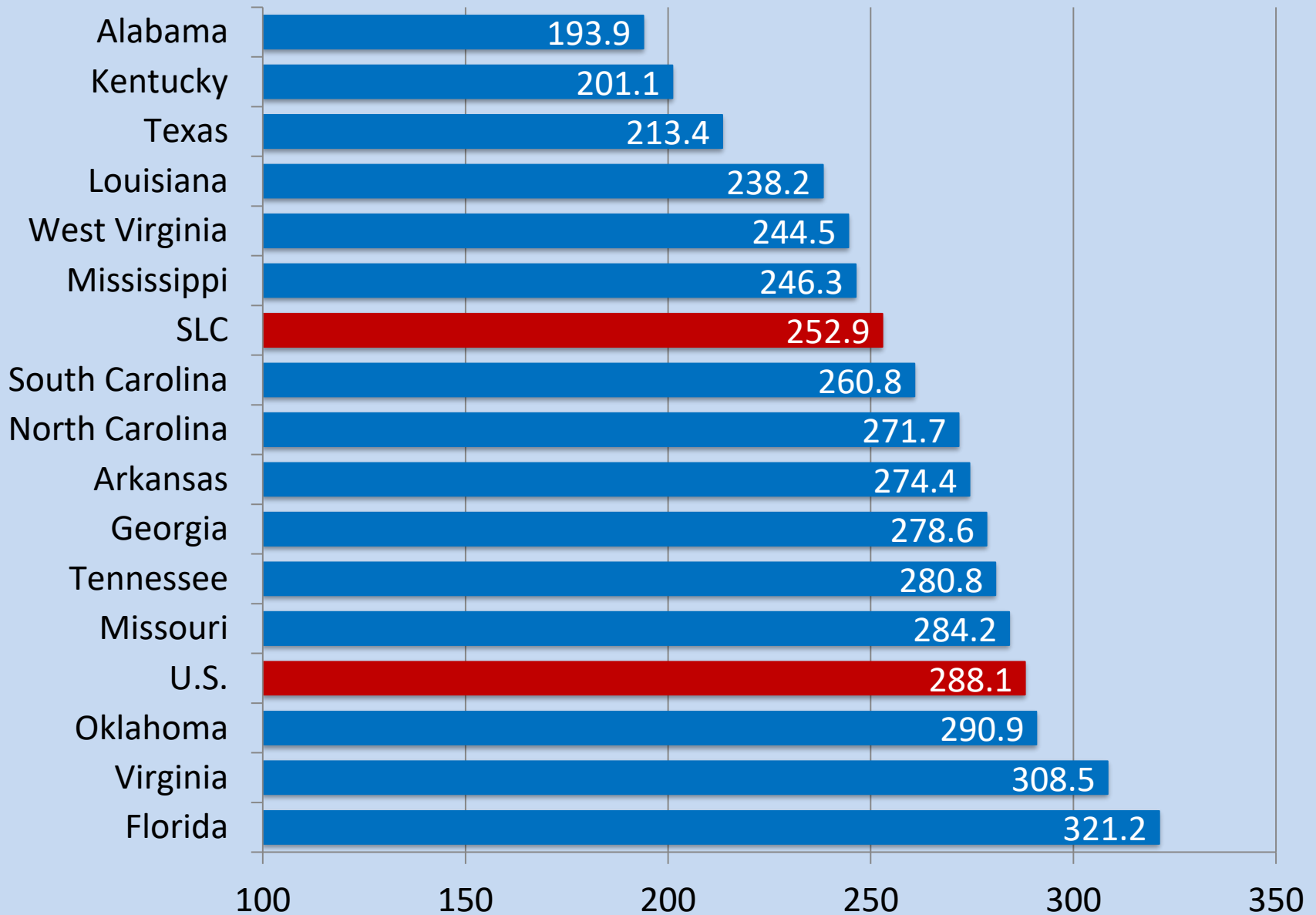


Student-Guidance Counselor Ratio (2014-15)



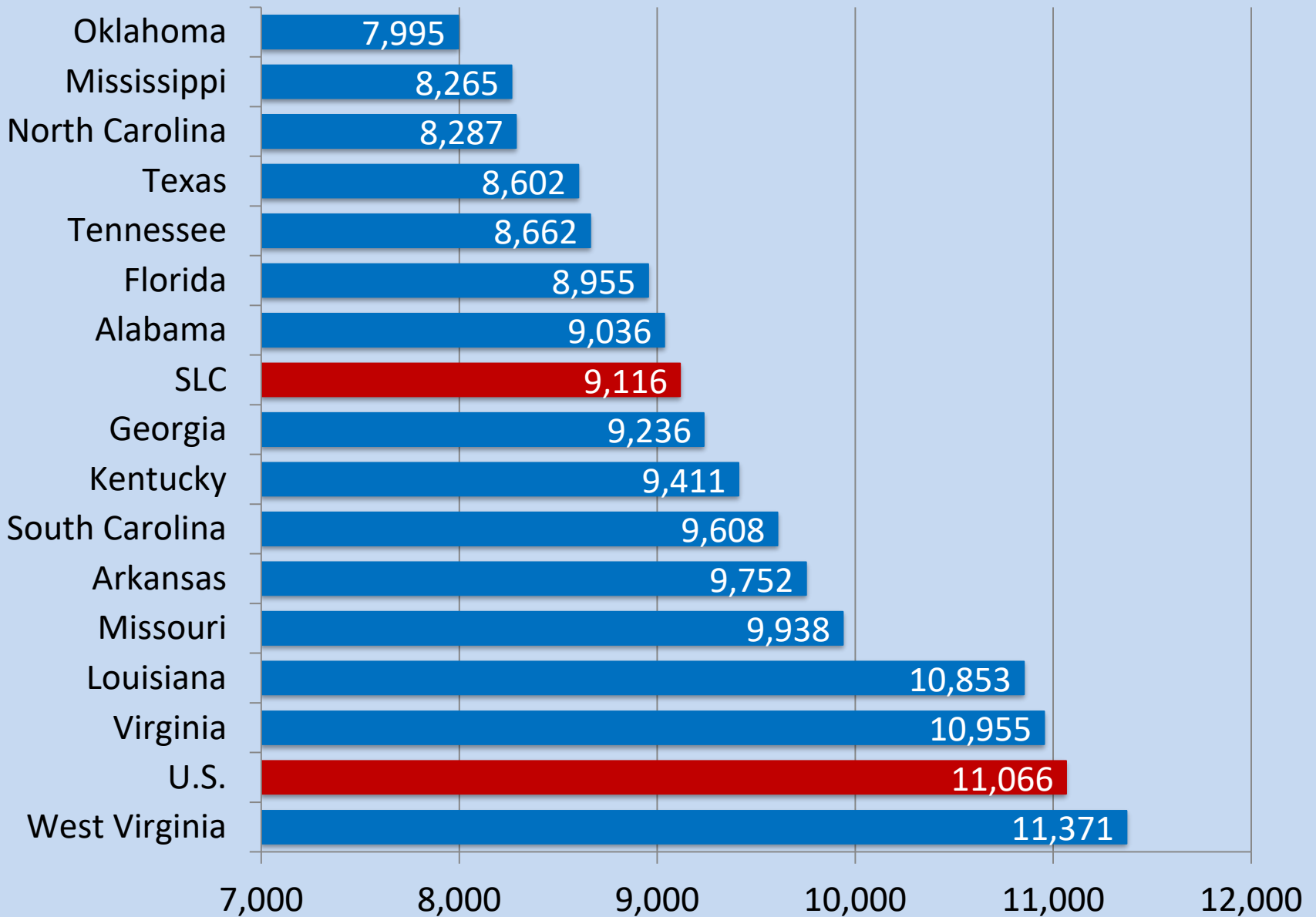

Student-School Administrator Ratio (2014-15)

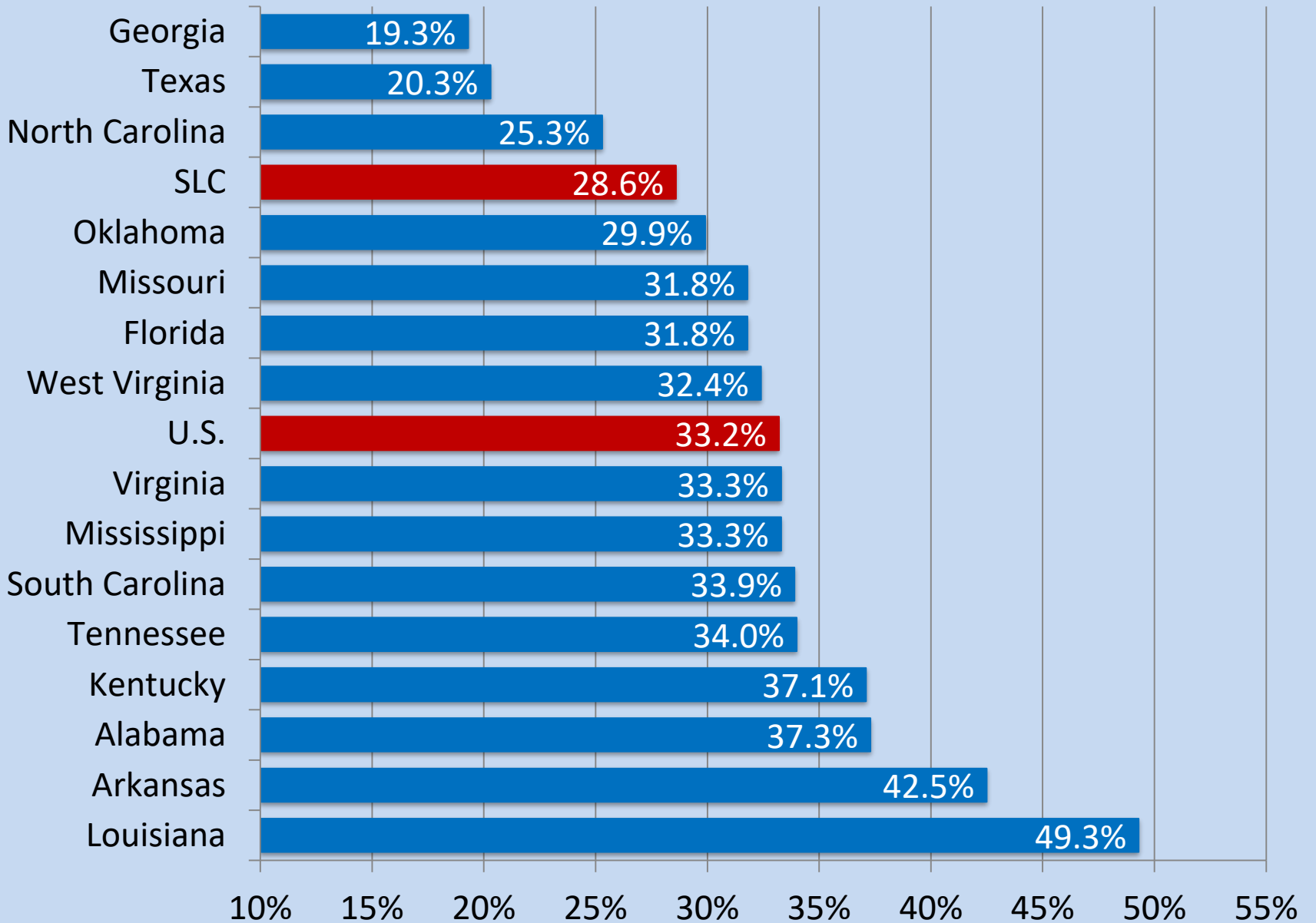

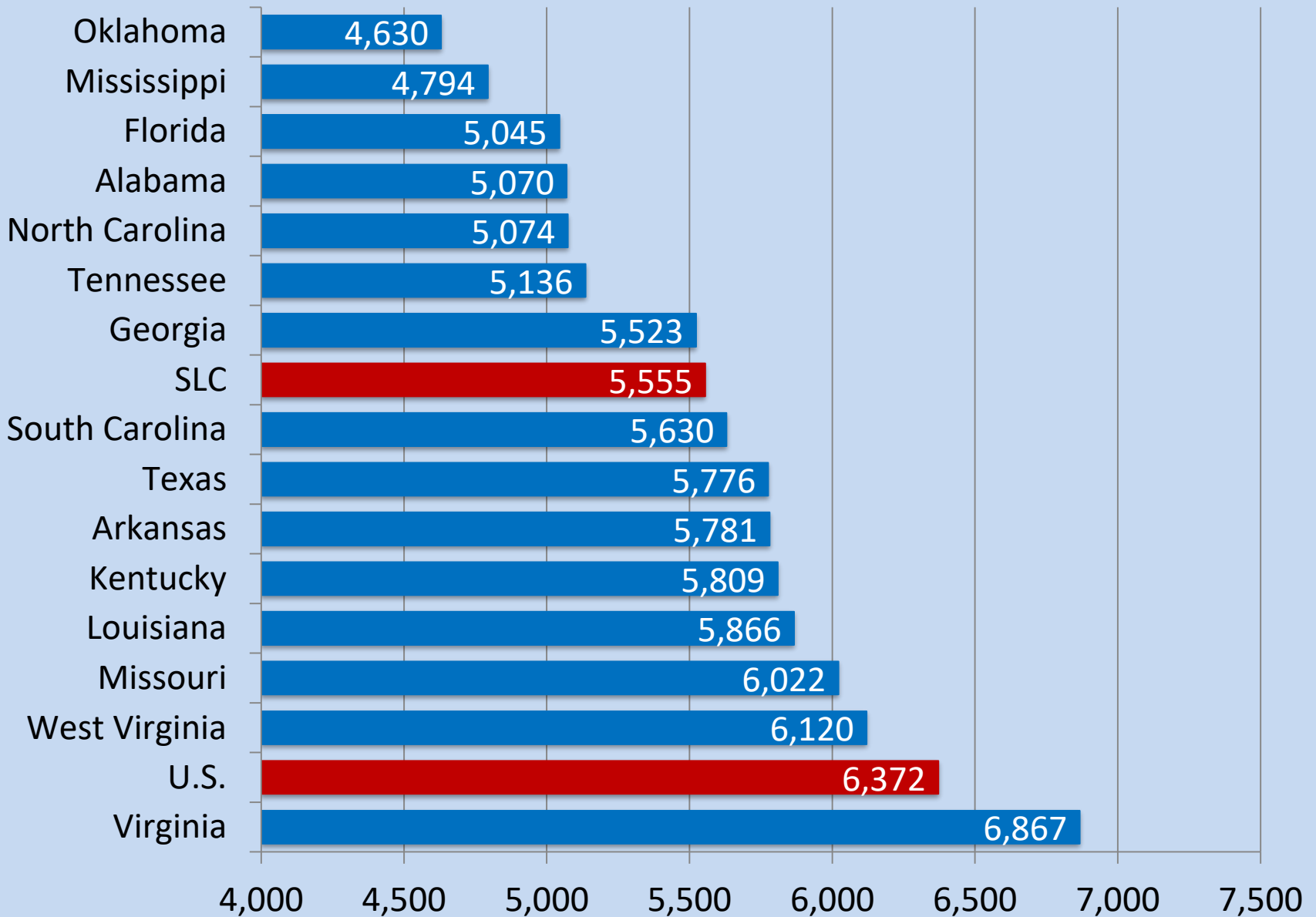
Current Expenditures Per Student (2013-14)
