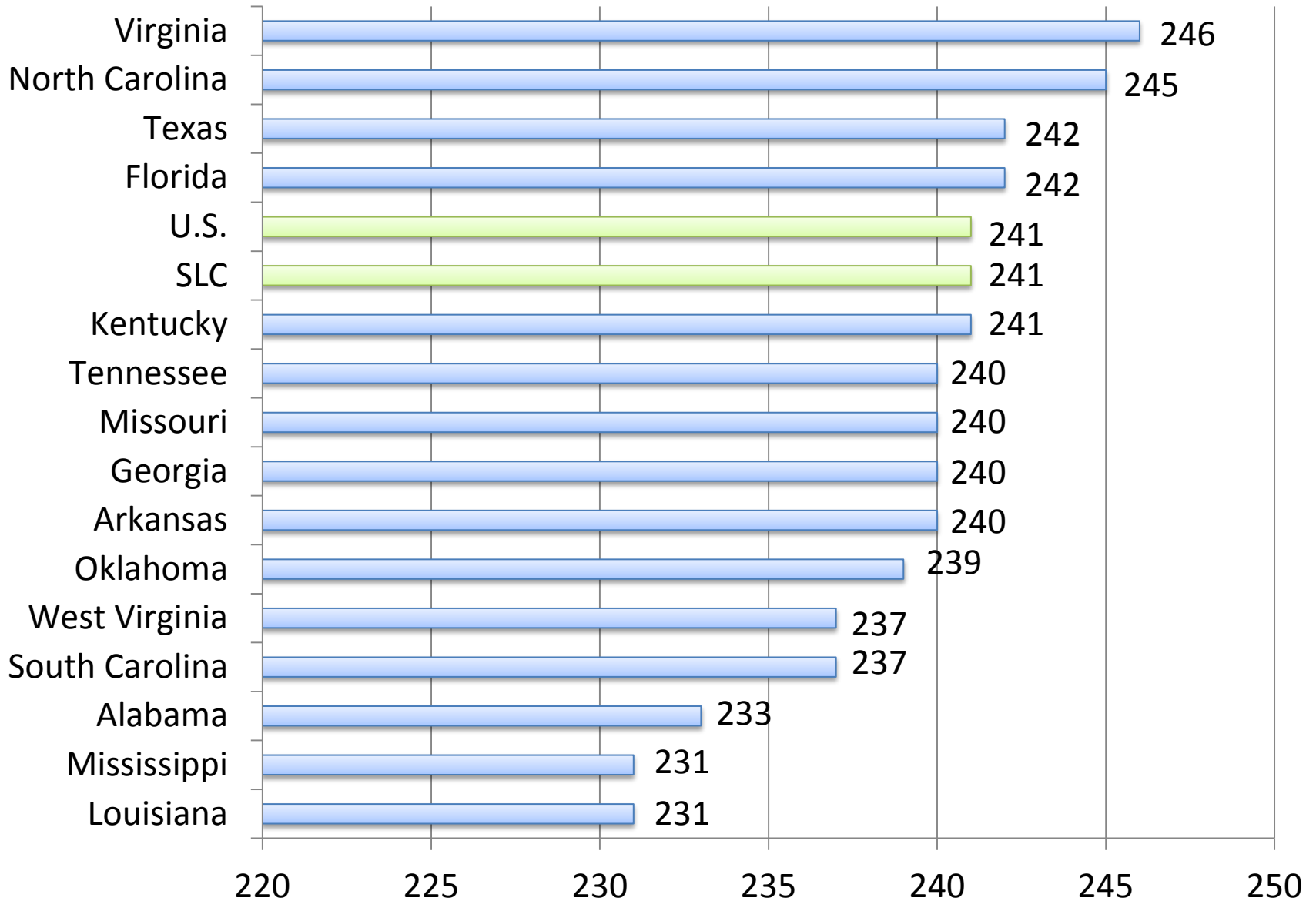

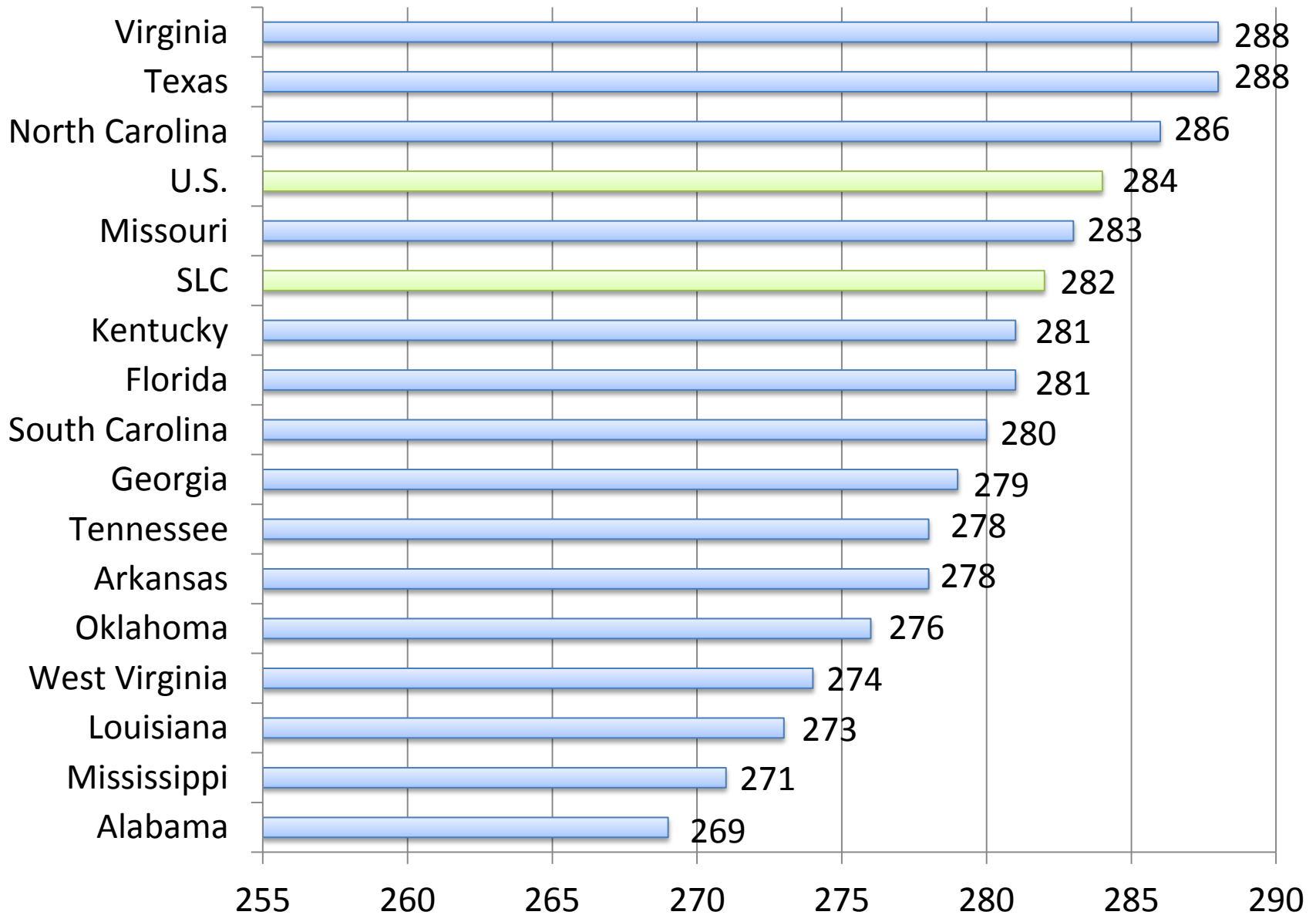

# 2013 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Math NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores

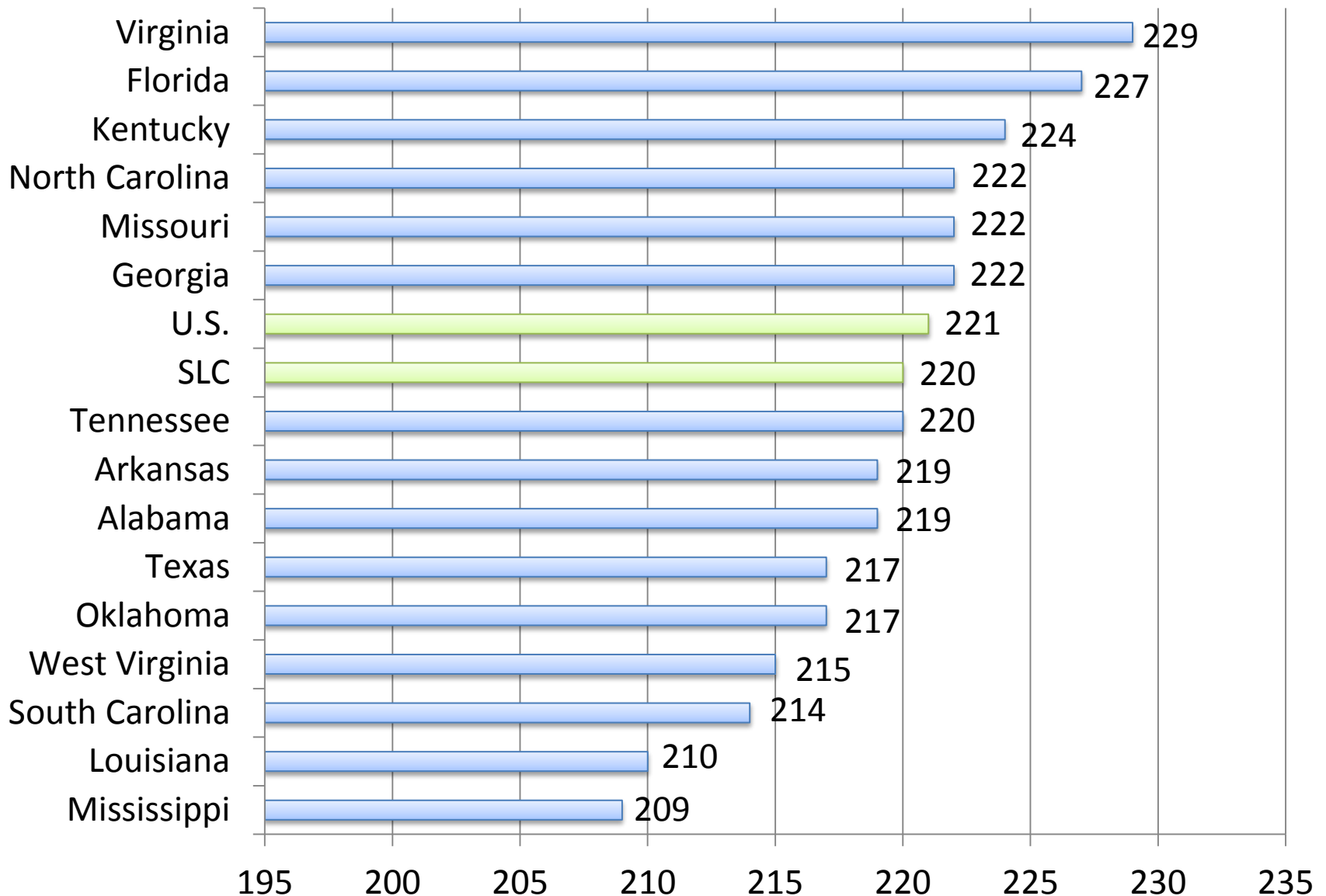

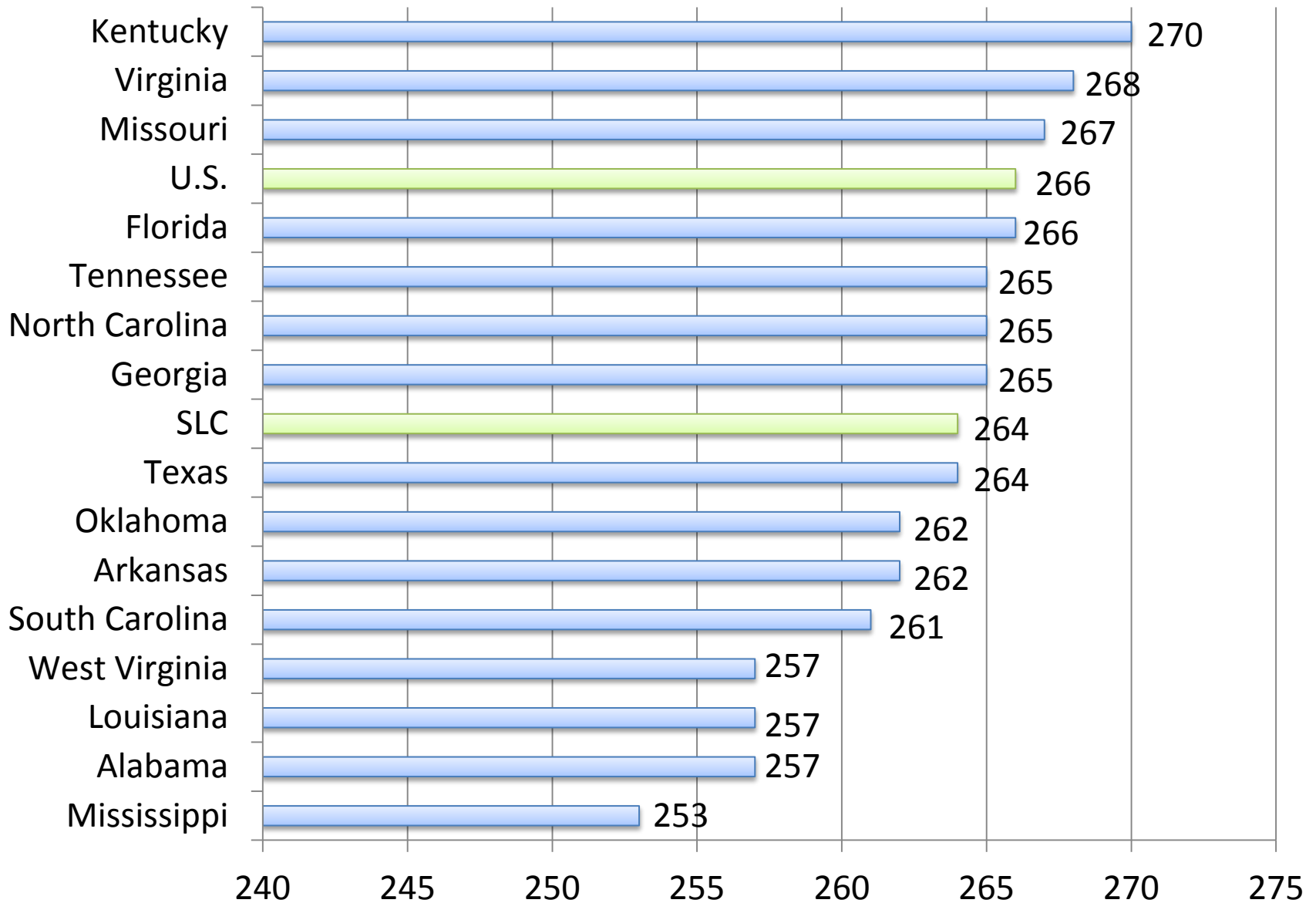
# 2013 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores



## 2013 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Reading NAEP Assessment Average Scale Scores

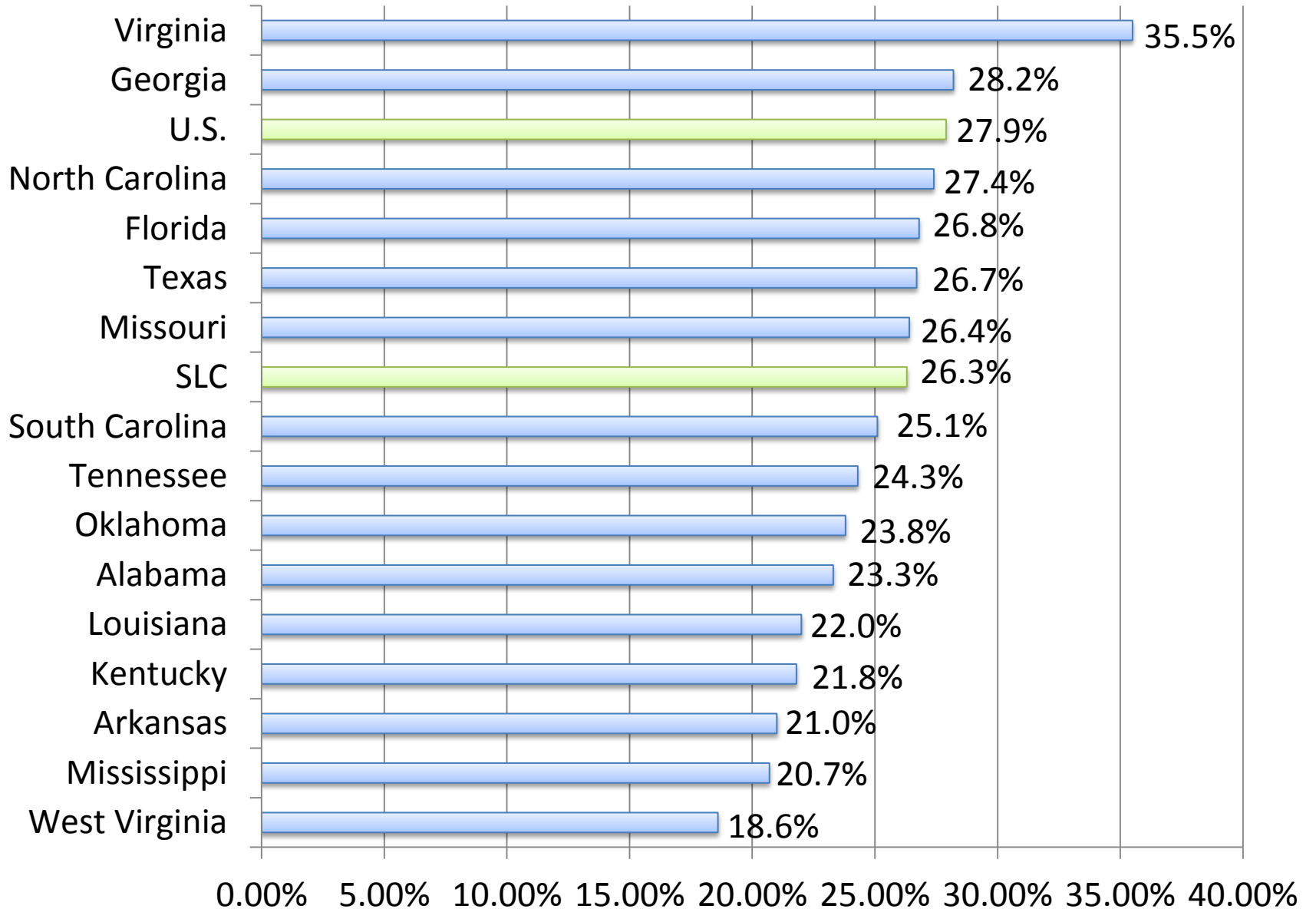

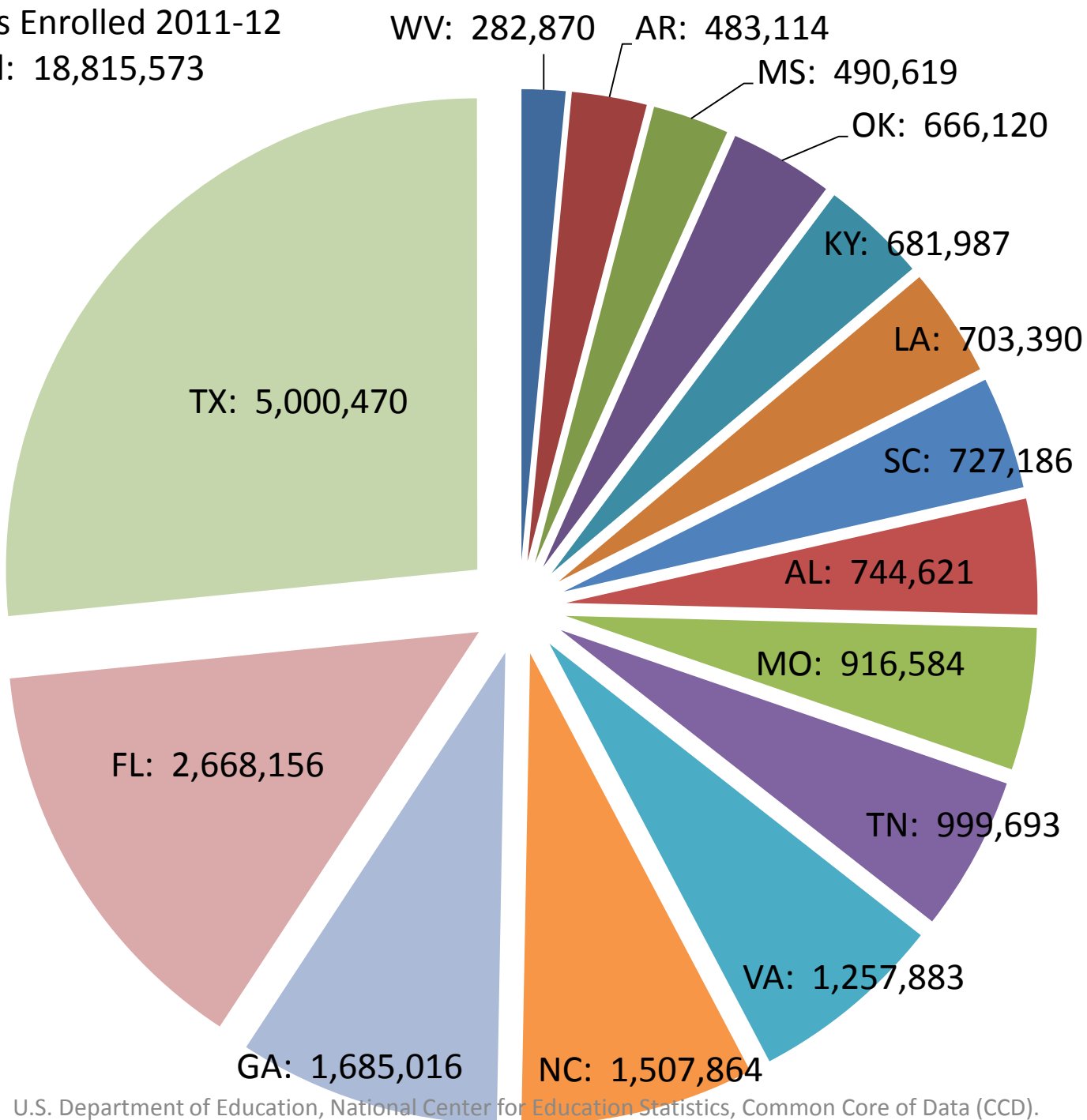
## Percentage of Population 25 or older with a Bachelor's Degree (2012)

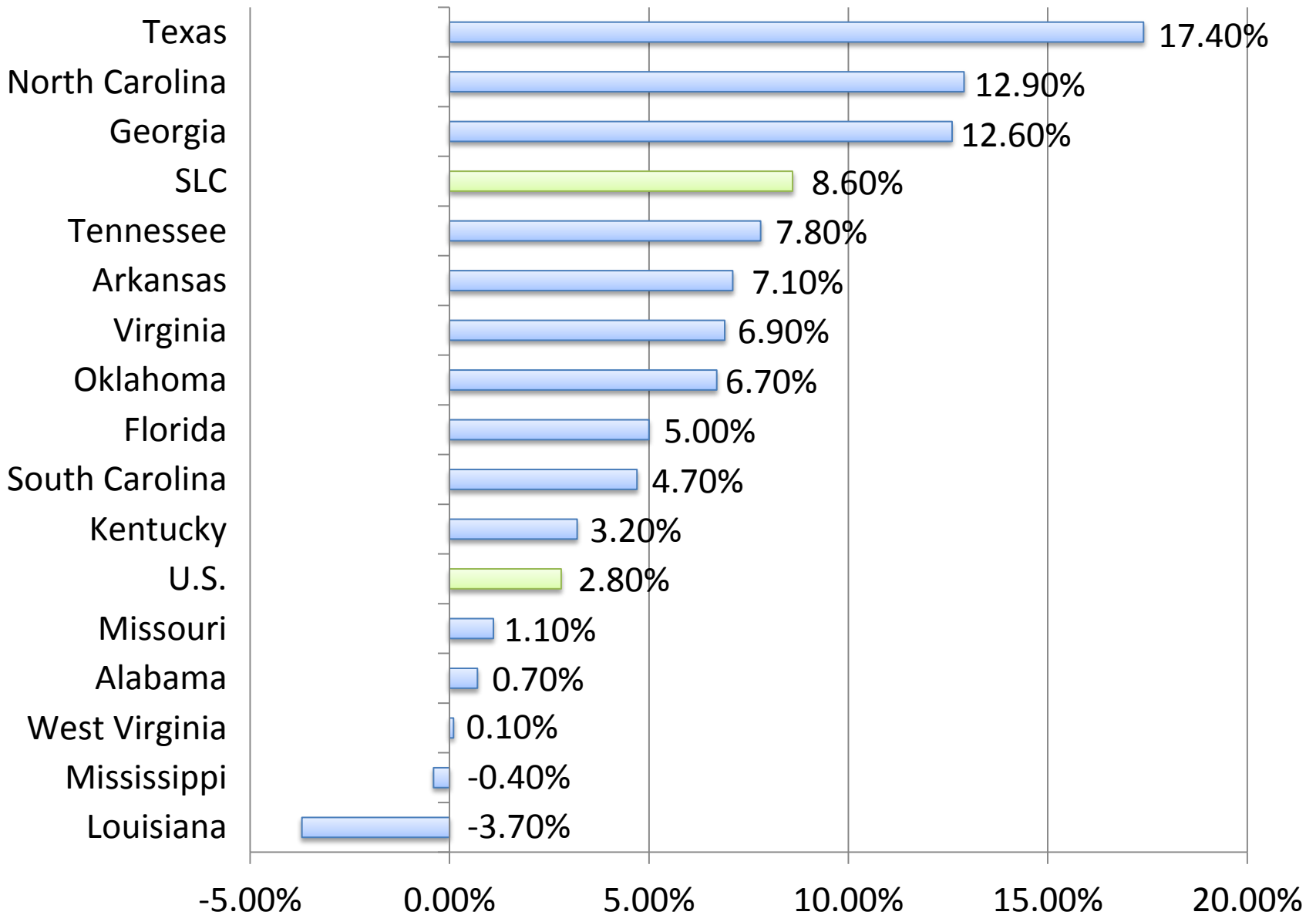
# Total Students Enrolled 2011-12

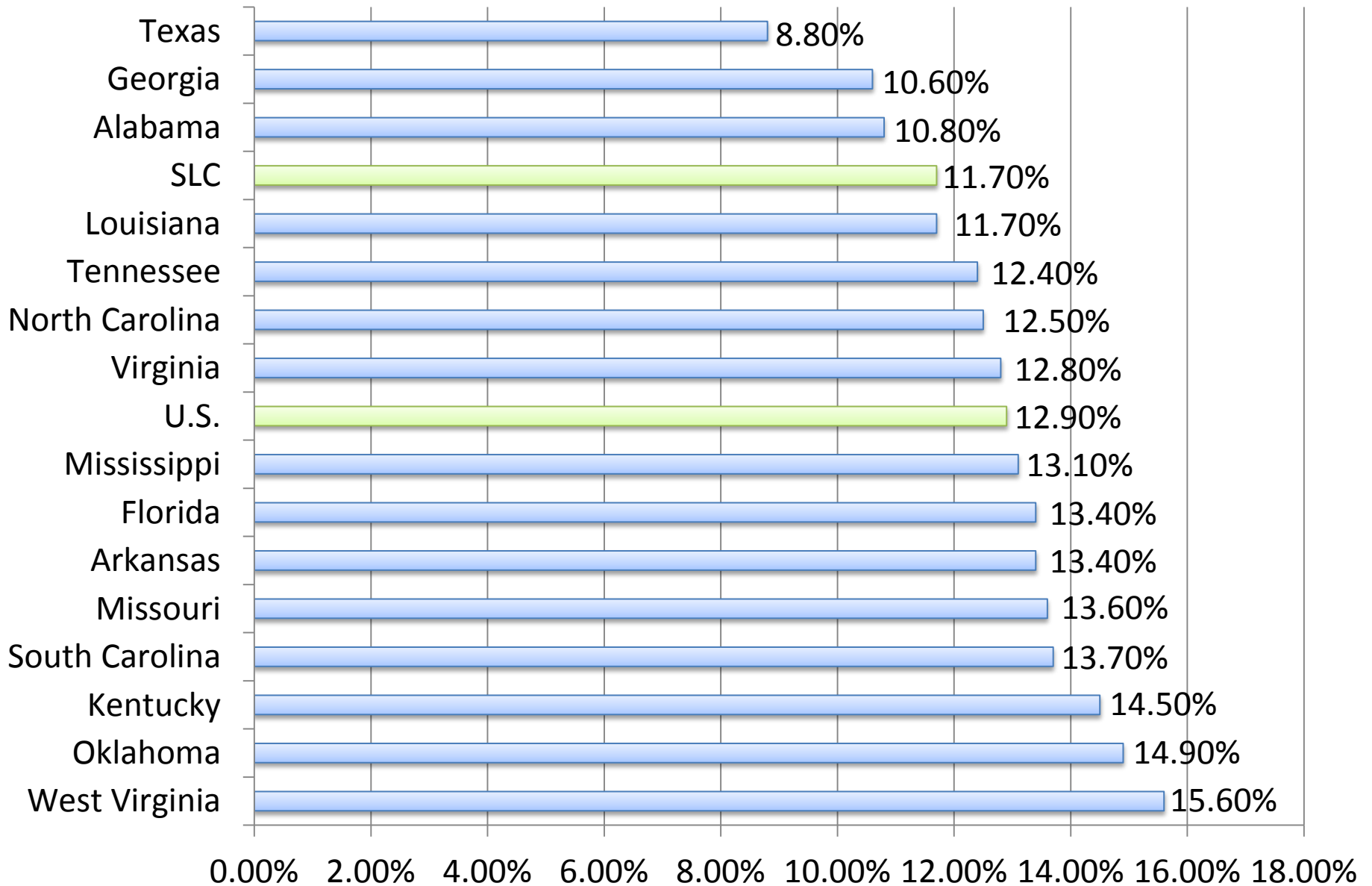
# Student Enrollment 10-Year Increase (between 2002-03 and 2011-12)

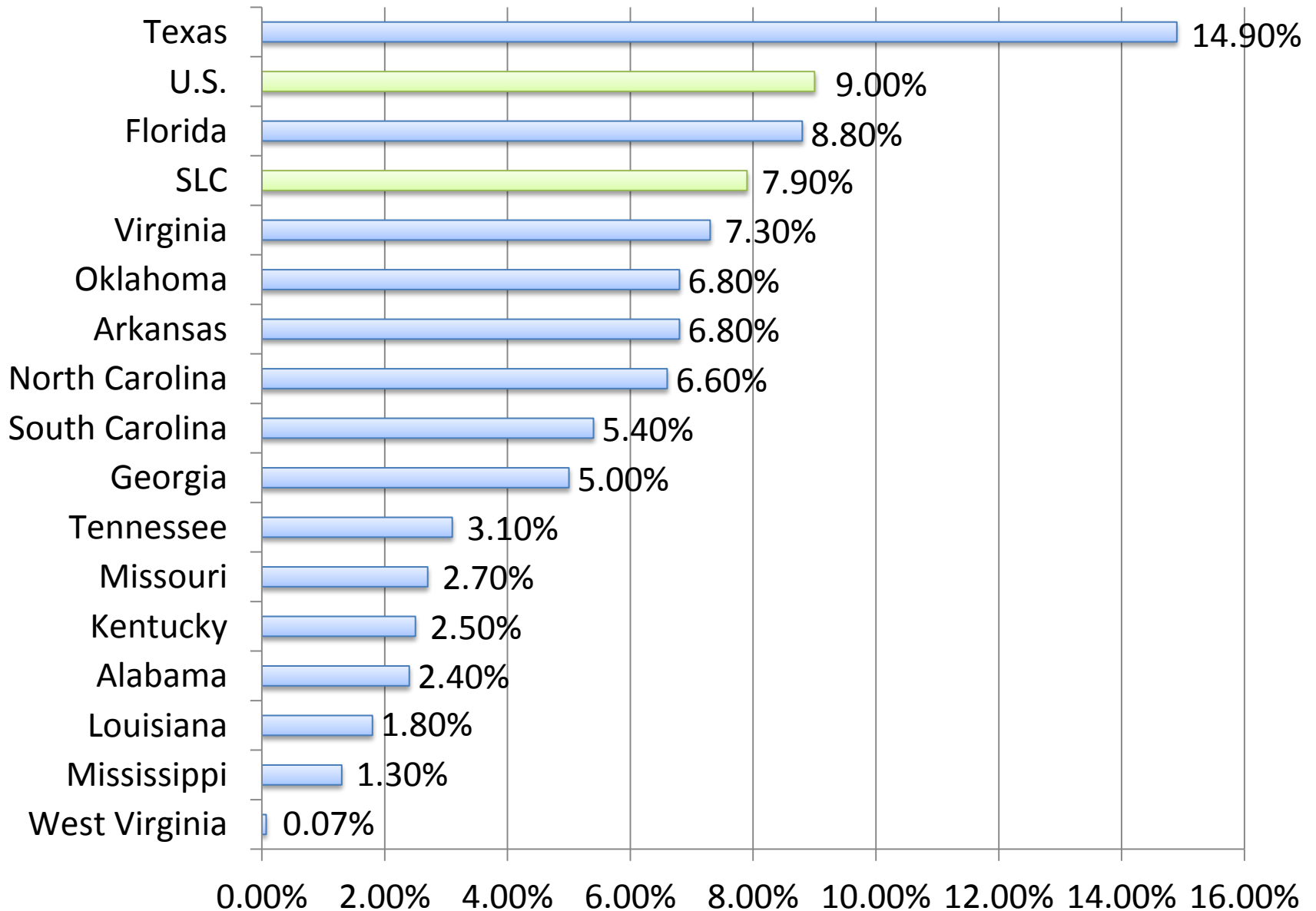


## Percentage of Students with IEPs (2011-12)



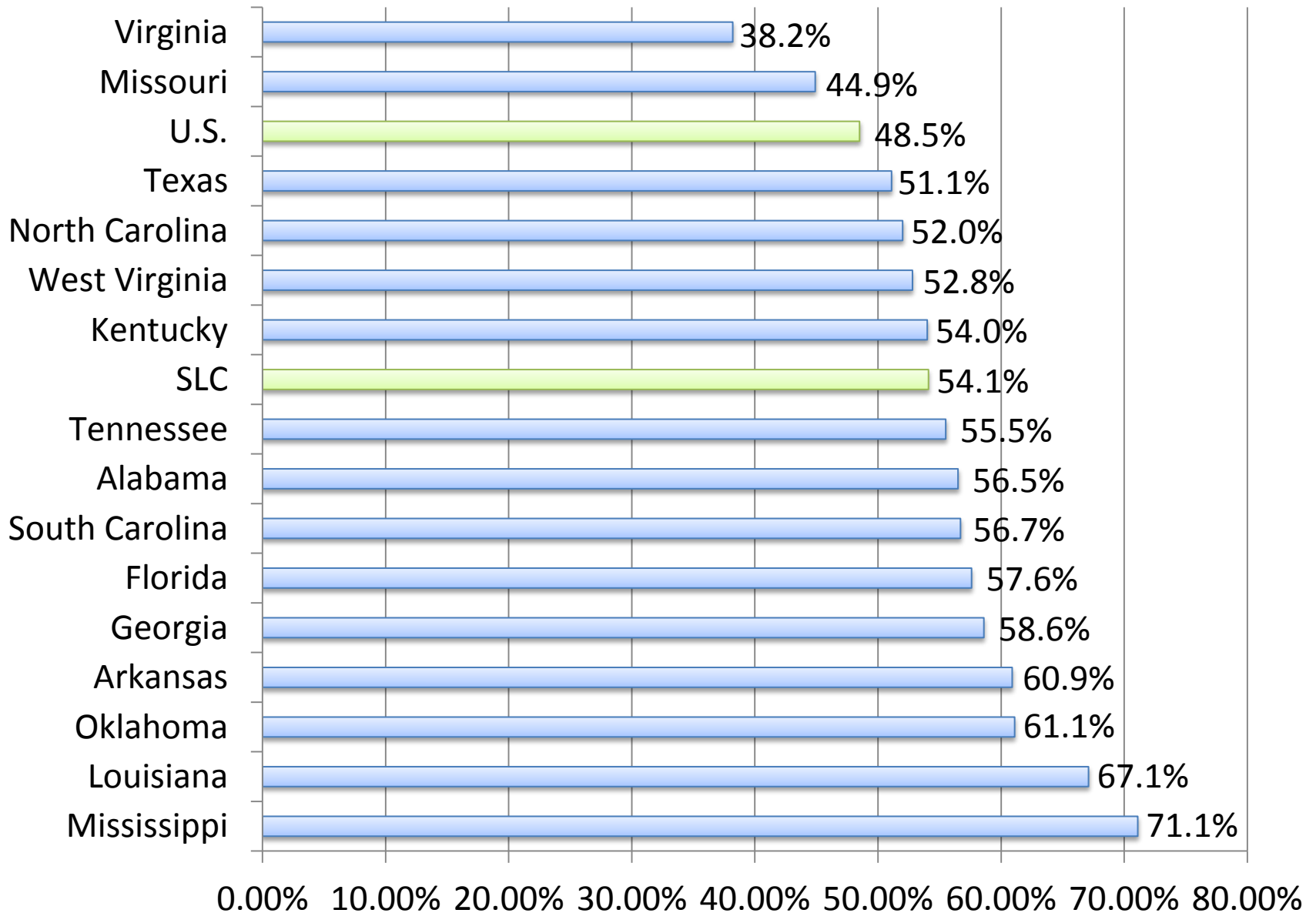

## Percentage of Students in LEP Programs (2011-12)



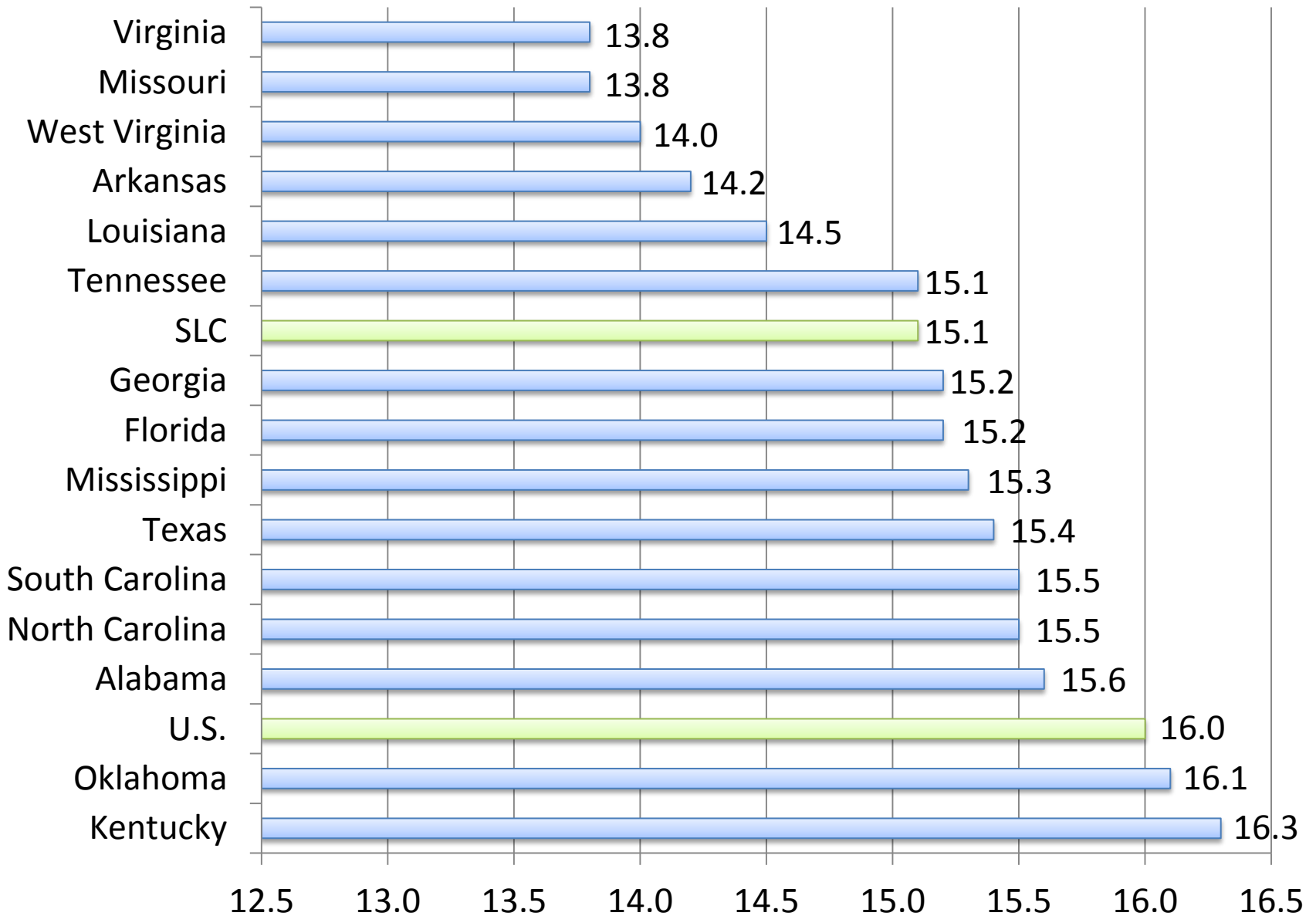

## Percentage of Students Eligible for Free/Reduced Lunch (2011-12)

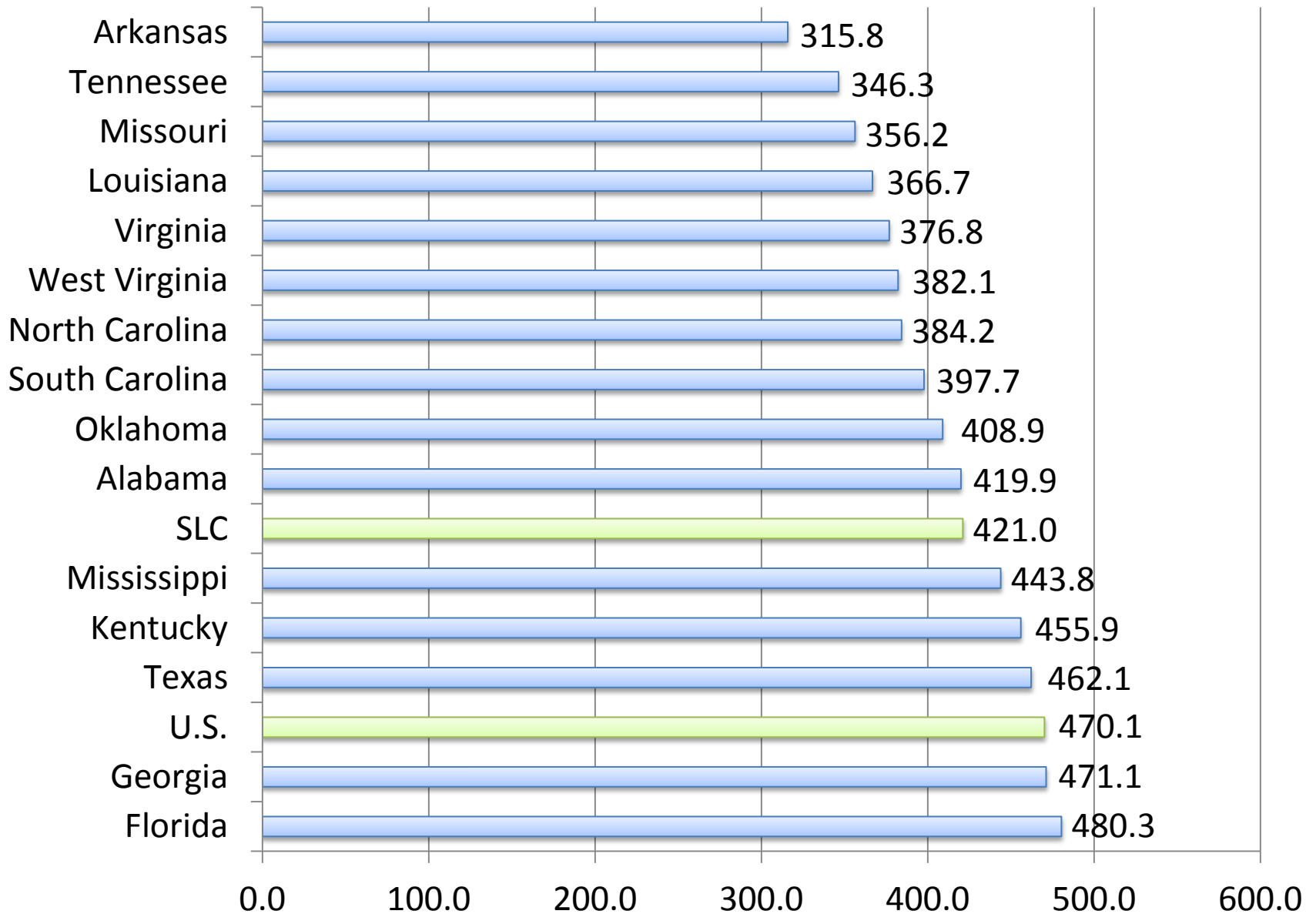

## Pupil-Teacher Ratio (2011-12)

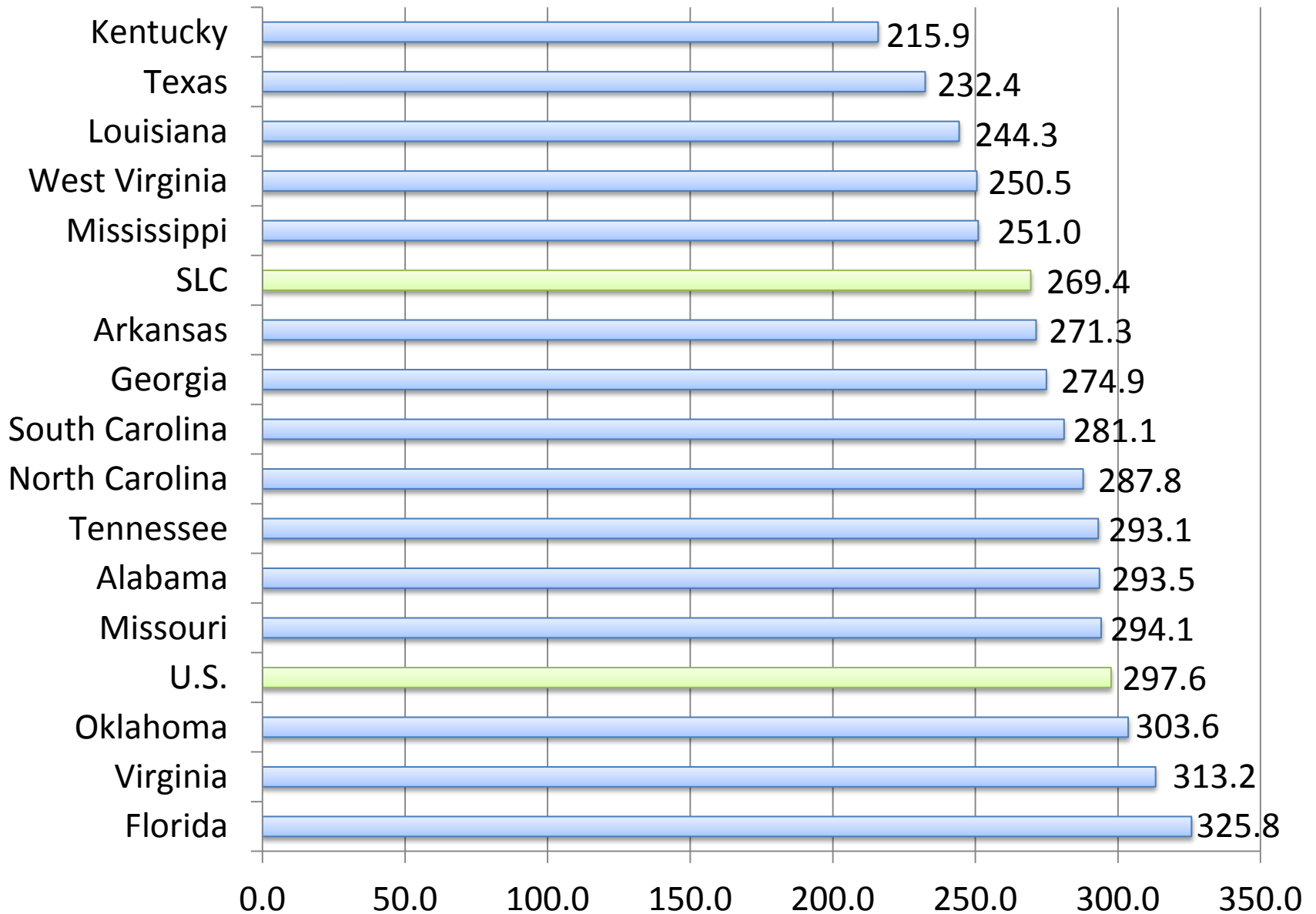


## Student-Guidance Counselor Ratio (2011-12)



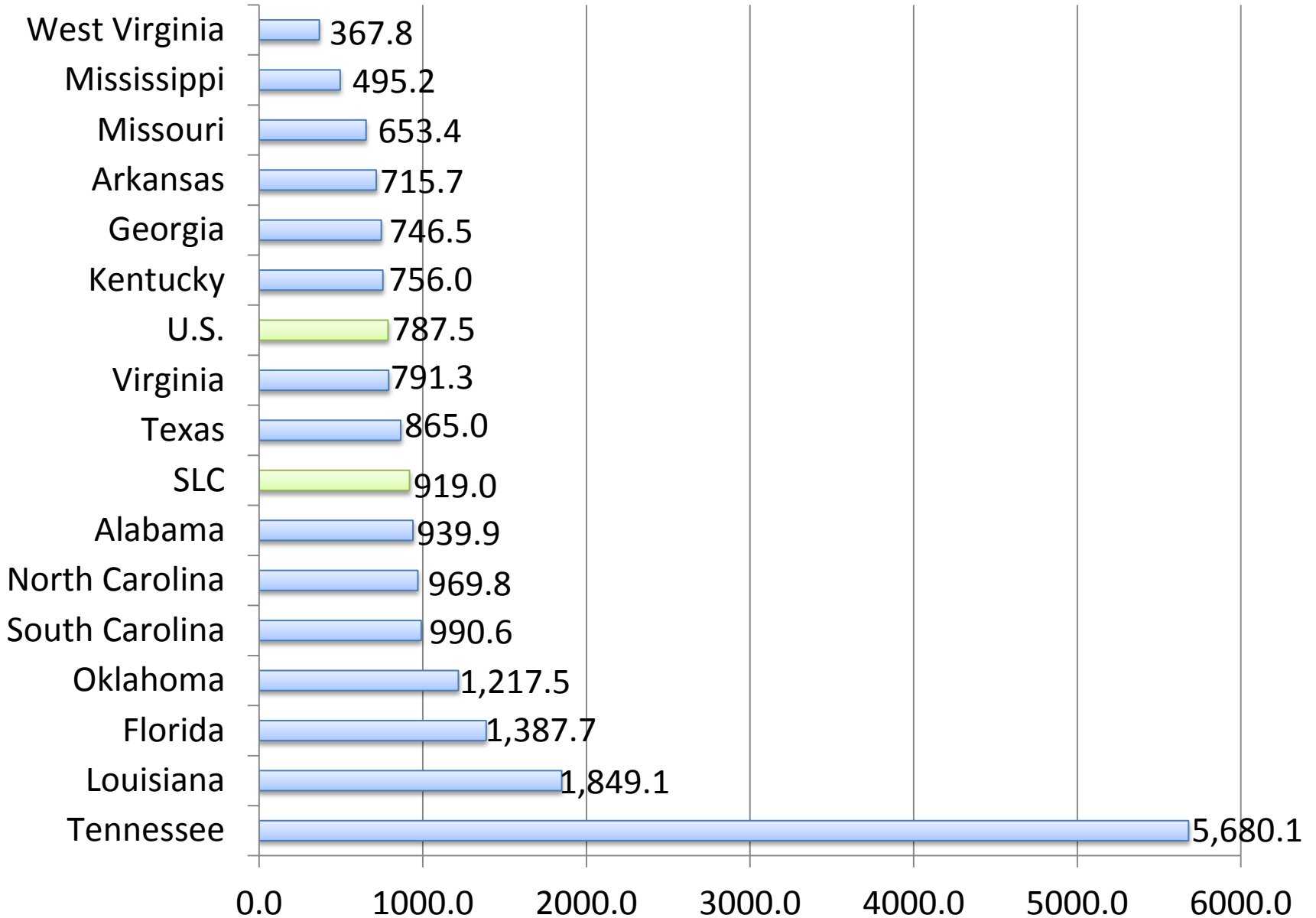

## Student-School Administrator Ratio (2011-12)



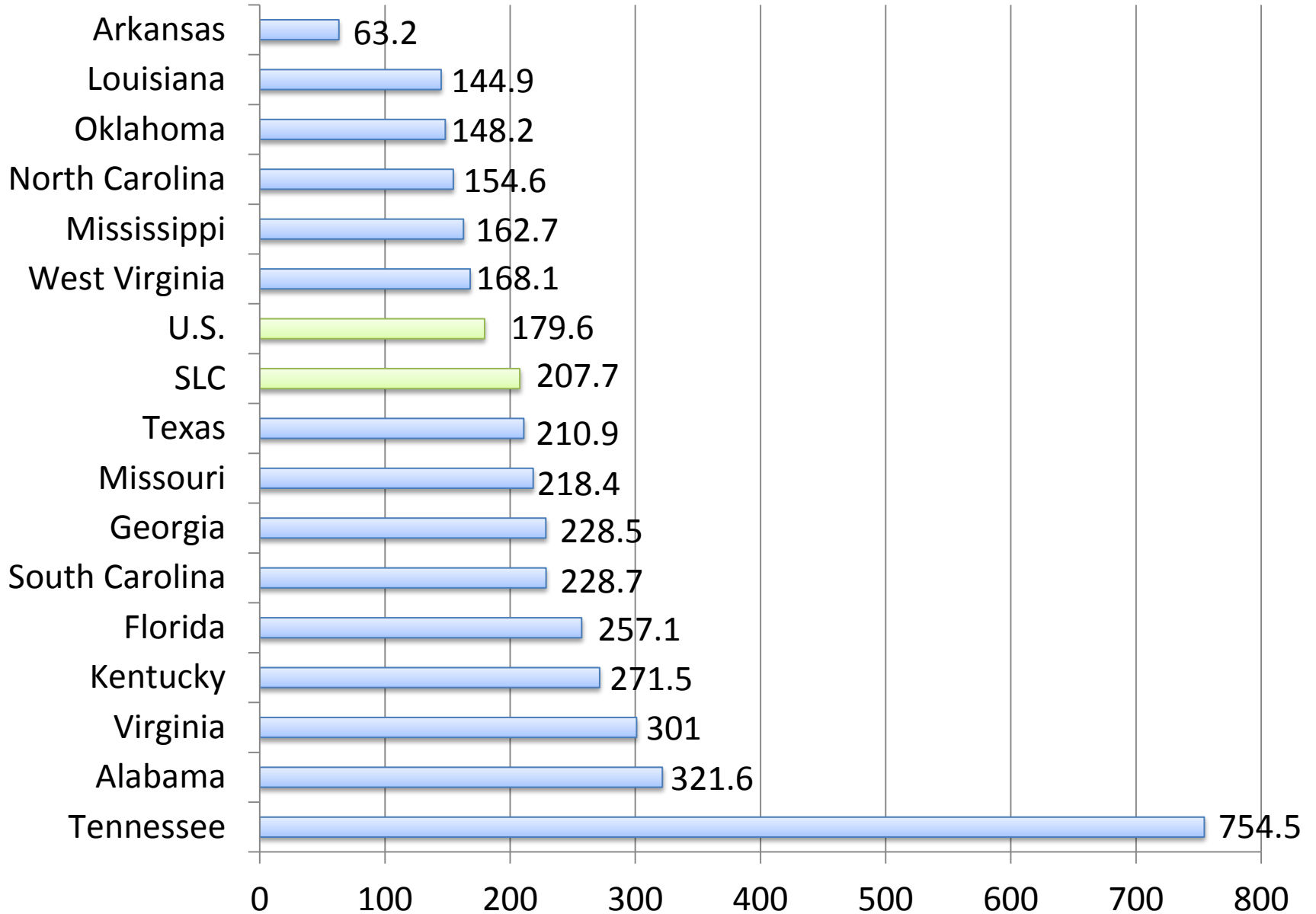

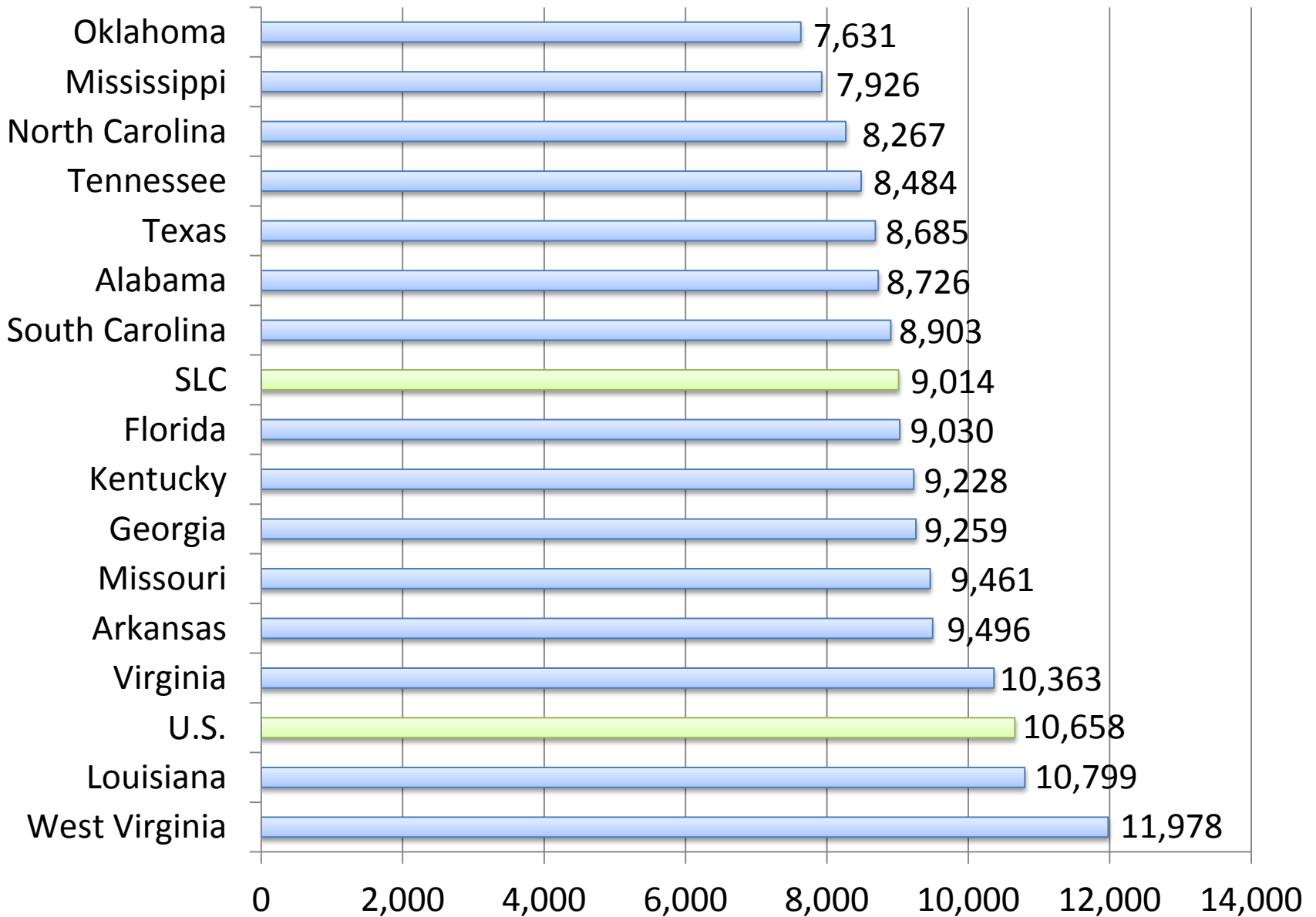
## Student-Student Support Services Staff Ratio (2011-12)



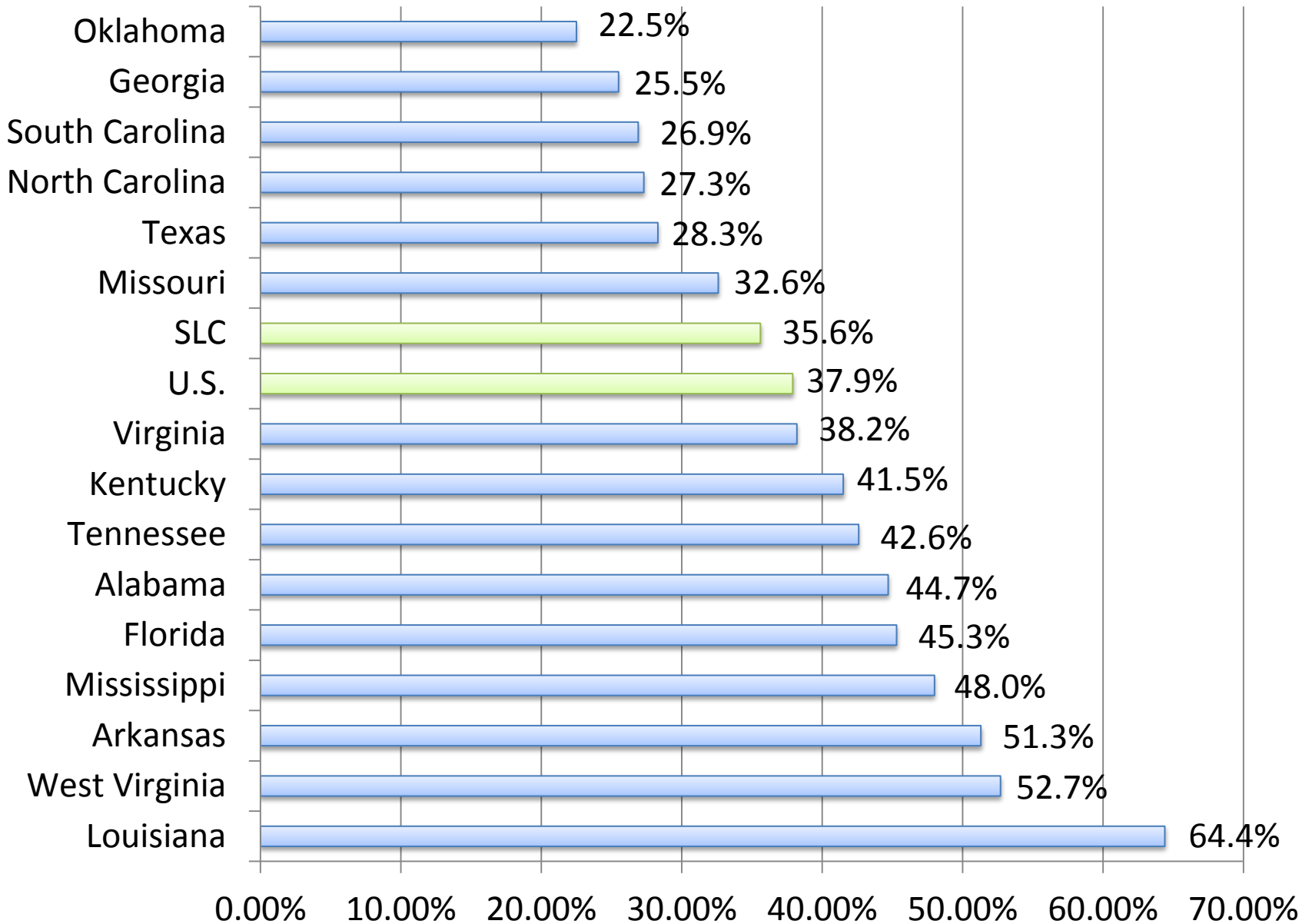

## Current Expenditures Per Student (2011-12)

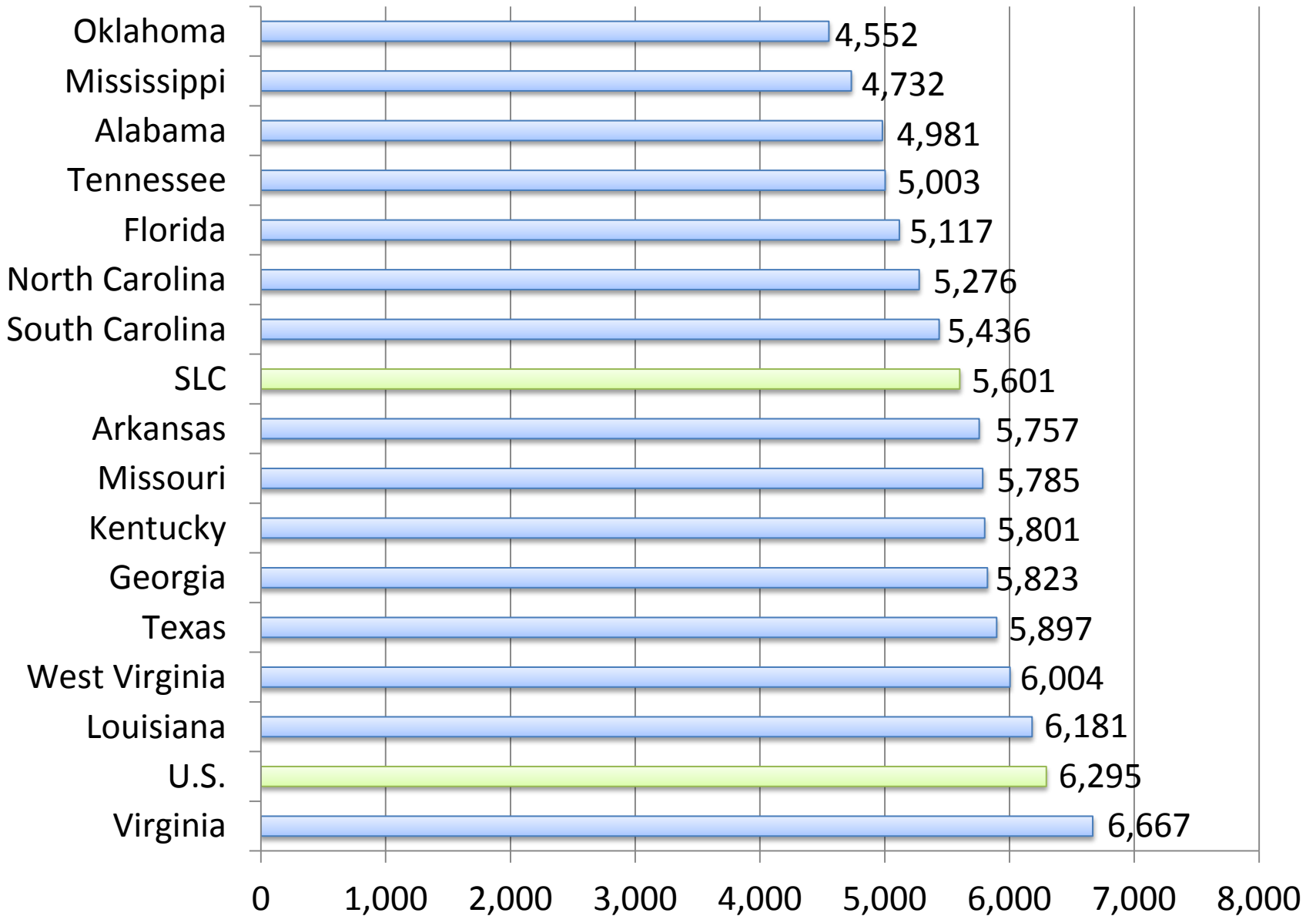


# Current Exp. Per Student 10-Year Increase (between 2001-02 and 2010-11)
