INTRODUCTION

This report includes tables, charts, graphs and other forms of data based upon the answers to a survey distributed to each member state in the Southern Legislative Conference. All data contained in this report has been drawn from the information reported to us as a result of that survey along with a review of each state's gaming statutes. Three states, Arkansas, Tennessee and Texas chose not to participate in this comparative gaming study. Consequently, the data contained in this report only reflects the current status of gaming in the remaining thirteen Southern Legislative Conference States.

As we learned throughout the survey process, the administration of gaming is handled differently by each state. Frequently, anywhere from two to four or more different agencies will have responsibility for different types of gaming within an individual state. This made the data retrieval process difficult and in some instances we were unsuccessful in obtaining data from every agency within a particular state. This resulted in some of the data being unavailable for this report and those instances are noted in the report.

This report includes, among other things, data on the various types of gaming authorized by each state, gaming revenues for fiscal years 1995 thru 2001, and state-imposed restrictions on gaming as well as a summary of gaming for each of the thirteen states.

Thanks to everyone in the various state agencies, departments, divisions, commissions and corporations who participated in this comparative data report by completing the survey. Your efforts in this regard are greatly appreciated.

Any comments, corrections, questions or suggestions you may have concerning this report will be welcomed.

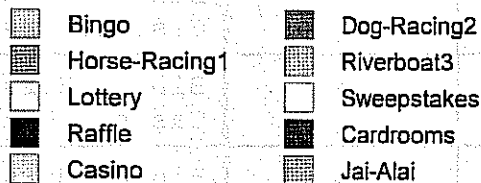
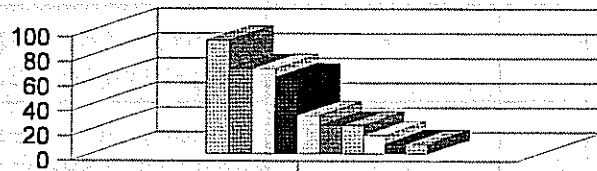
