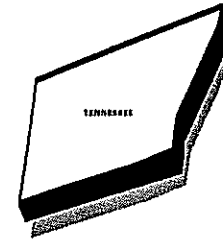

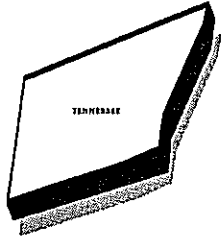

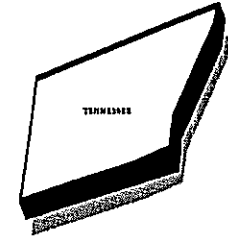

THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IS NOT CURRENTLY UNDER A FEDERAL OR STATE COURT ORDER DURING THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005.

STATE INITIATIVES

ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES

ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES ARE PLACED IN HOUSING SETTINGS ACCORDING TO THEIR NEEDS AND THE RESOURCES OF THE FACILITY WHERE THEY ARE HOUSED. THE DEPARTMENT MAINTAINS A 50 BED GERIATRIC UNIT AT THE WAYNE COUNTY BOOT CAMP. THE RESIDENTS OF THIS UNIT ARE AMBULATORY AND DO NOT REQUIRE DAILY SKILLED CARE. INMATES REQUIRING DAILY SKILLED CARE OR WHO HAVE CONDITIONS THAT REQUIRE CLOSE MONITORING (MAY OR MAY NOT BE ELDERLY) ARE PLACED AT THE DeBERRY SPECIAL NEEDS FACILITY. THERE IS NO SPECIAL FUNDING OR SEPARATE FACILITIES FOR ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES.

PRISON BASED SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS

THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS HAS A NUMBER OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS:

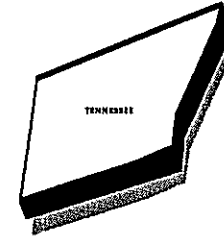
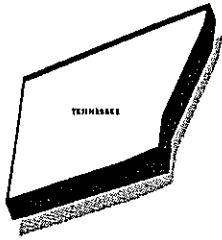
- THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITY TREATMENT IS LIMITED TO INMATES WITH EXTENSIVE SUBSTANCE ABUSE HISTORIES. THE PROGRAM LENGTH IS 6-12 MONTHS 7 DAYS A WEEK. INMATES ASSIGNED TO TC SHALL BE HOUSED IN A SEPARATE HOUSING UNIT SET APART FROM GENERAL POPULATION.
- GROUP COUNSELING TREATMENT IS DESIGNED FOR THE INMATES WHO ARE RECOMMENDED DURING ASSESSMENT FOR GROUP COUNSELING FOR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY. THE PROGRAM LENGTH IS 3-6 MONTHS 2-4 TIMES WEEKLY.
- DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO TEACH INMATES ABOUT THE DANGERS OF THEIR SUBSTANCE USE AND HOW IT AFFECTS THEM COGNITIVELY. THE PROGRAM LENGTH IS 1-3 MONTHS AND GROUPS ARE HELD 2-3 TIMES WEEKLY. DRUG AWARENESS IS NOT CONSIDERED A TREATMENT PROGRAM.

ESTIMATED COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMMING ARE \$1.8 MILLION. THE TOTAL ANNUAL CAPACITY FOR THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMS IS 2,060. THE PROGRAMS ARE OFFERED AT 12 OF TENNESSEE'S FACILITIES. THE TC PROGRAMS RECIDIVISM RATES ARE 26% LOWER THAN THE DEPARTMENT'S OVERALL RECIDIVISM OF 55%.

PRE-RELEASE/POST-RELEASE ("REENTRY") PROGRAMS

DURING THE 2004/2005, THE TN DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS CONTINUED TO EXPAND ITS PRE-RELEASE PROGRAM TO BENEFIT MORE OF THE 5,600 INMATES LEAVING STATE CUSTODY. EACH OF THE STATE'S 12 ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES AND THE 3 PRIVATELY CONTRACTED FACILITIES NOW OFFER A 90 DAY PRE-RELEASE PROGRAM TO INMATES LEAVING CUSTODY BY WAY OF PROBATION, PAROLE, OR EXPIRATION OF SENTENCE. ONLY ONE OF THE INSTITUTIONS HAVE DEVELOPED THEIR PRE-RELEASE PROGRAM TO BE "PAID JOB SLOT" FOR THE PARTICIPANTS. PRE-RELEASE PROGRAMS ARE FUNDED AND STAFFED BY THE TN DOC STATE BUDGET. SEVERAL INSTITUTIONS HAVE ACCESS TO VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS AND SERVICES THAT COMPLEMENT THE EXISTING PROGRAMS. THE TN PRISON FOR WOMEN CONTRACTS PRE-RELEASE SERVICES THROUGH THE YMCA. IN ADDITION, THE TN DOC HAS INTENSIVE REENTRY PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE USDOJ, SERIOUS AND VIOLENT OFFENDER REENTRY INITIATIVE, WHICH WILL END IN SEPTEMBER 2005. TN BRIDGES HAS 261 INDIVIDUALS PARTICIPATING. A COMPARATIVE STUDY FOUND THAT TN BRIDGES RECIDIVISM RATE IS 29.5% COMPARED TO 53.2% FOR THE CONTROL GROUP.

CONCERNS WITH AGING ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

TENNESSEE HAS 21 TOTAL FACILITIES. THE OLDEST IS 109 YEARS OLD. THE NEWEST STATE RUN FACILITY IS 13 YEARS OLD, WHILE A CCA FACILITY THAT HOUSES STATE INMATES IS ONLY 3 YEARS OLD.
