Louisiana Office of Motor Vehicle Commissioner Karen G. St.

Germain was appointed by Governor John Bel Edwards in January of 2016 to head one of the most vital of state agencies. Her mission and directive is to continue her commitment to public service and to make the Office more efficient and responsive to the citizens of Louisiana.

Karen G. St. Germain was first elected to the Louisiana House of Representatives in 2003, and served the constituents in District 60 through 2016. Representative St. Germain served as the Chairwoman for the House Transportation, Highways, and Public Works Committee. She was also a member of the House Executive Committee, the Joint Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay, the House Committee on Homeland Security, and the Joint Committee on Homeland Security. In addition, Representative St. Germain served as a member of the Acadiana Delegation, The Capital Regional Legislative Delegation, the Democratic Caucus, and the Louisiana Rural Caucus. She was also Chairwoman of the Atchafalaya Basin Subcommittee, as well as of the Louisiana Women's Caucus. She was also appointed to the Louisiana Fire and Emergency Training Commission in 2012 by Governor Jindal. Prior to her election into the Louisiana House of Representatives, she worked as a legislative assistant for former Representatives Charlie Melancon and Audrey McCain.

During her tenure, Representative St. Germain was named Legislator of the Year by the Child Care Association of Louisiana, Inc., the Louisiana State Troopers Association, the Professional Fire Fighters Association of Louisiana, and the Louisiana State Firemen's Association. She was also named Conservation Legislator of the Year by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation, and the National Wildlife Federation.

Representative St. Germain is married to Kenneth St. Germain, and together they have three sons, and reside in Pierre Part.
